modern information and communication technologies make it easier for individuals to be involved in their own health and social care they also facilitate contact between individuals and service providers and deliver more efficient tools for healthcare staff artificial intelligence ai promises to bring even more benefits in the future with more effectiveness and the provision of decision support this book presents the proceedings of the 33rd medical informatics europe conference mie2023 held in gothenburg sweden from 22 to 25 may 2023 the theme of mie2023 was caring is sharing exploiting value in data for health and innovation stressing the increasing importance of sharing digital health data and the related challenges the sharing of health data is developing rapidly both in europe and beyond so the focus of the conference was on the enabling of trustworthy sharing of data to improve health topics covered include healthcare community care self care public health and the innovation and development of future proof digital health solutions and the almost 300 papers divided into 10 chapters also cover important advances in the sub domains of biomedical informatics decision support systems clinical information systems clinical research informatics knowledge management and representation consumer health informatics natural language processing public health informatics privacy ethical and societal aspects among them describing innovative approaches to the collection organization analysis and data sharing related to health and wellbeing the book contributes to the expertise required to take medical informatics to the next level and will be of interest to all those working in the field

how can dedicated ethics committees members fulfill their complex roles as moral analysts policy reviewers and clinical consultants the joint commission tjc accredits and certifies more than 19 000 health care organizations in the united states including hospitals nursing homes and home care agencies each organization must have a standing health care ethics committee to maintain its status these interdisciplinary committees are composed of physicians nurses attorneys ethicists administrators and interested citizens their main function is to review and provide resolutions for specific individual patient care problems many of these committees are well meaning but may lack the information experience skills and formal background in bioethics needed to adequately negotiate the complex ethical issues that arise in clinical and organizational settings handbook for health care ethics committees was the first book of its kind to address the myriad responsibilities faced by ethics

committees including education case consultation and policy development adopting an accessible tone and using a case study format the authors explore serious issues involving informed consent and refusal decision making and decisional capacity truth telling the end of life palliative care justice in and access to health care services and organizational ethics the authors have thoroughly updated the content and expanded their focus in the second edition to include ethics committees in other clinical settings such as long term care facilities small community hospitals rehabilitation centers and hospices they have added three new chapters that address reproduction disability and the special needs of the elder population and they provide additional specialized policies and procedures on the book s website this guide is an essential resource for all health care ethics committee members

it has become trite to observe that increases in health care costs have become unsustainable how best for policy to address these increases however depends in part on the degree to which they represent increases in the real quantity of medical services as opposed to increased unit prices of existing services and an even more fundamental question is the degree to which the increased spending actually has purchased improved health accounting for health and health care addresses both these issues the government agencies responsible for measuring unit prices for medical services have taken steps in recent years that have greatly improved the accuracy of those measures nonetheless this book has several recommendations aimed at further improving the price indices

the ethical theories employed in health care today assume in the main a modern western philosophical framework yet the diversity of cultural and religious assumptions regarding human nature health and illness life and death and the status of the individual suggest that a cross cultural study of health care ethics is needed a cross cultural dialogue on health care ethics provides this study it shows that ethical questions can be resolved by examining the ethical principles present in each culture critically assessing each value and identifying common values found within all traditions it encourages the development of global awareness and sensitivity to and respect for the diversity of peoples and their values and will advance understanding as well as help to foster a greater balance and a fuller truth in consideration of the human condition and what makes for health and wholeness

as the united states devotes extensive resources to health care evaluating how successfully the u s system delivers high quality high value care in an equitable manner is essential at the request of congress the agency for healthcare research and quality ahrq annually produces the national healthcare quality report nhqr and the national healthcare disparities report nhdr the reports have revealed areas in which health care performance has improved over time but they also have identified major shortcomings after five years of producing the nhqr and nhdr ahrq asked the iom for guidance on how to improve the next generation of reports the iom concludes that the nhqr and nhdr can be improved in ways that would make them more influential in promoting change in the health care system in addition to being sources of data on past trends the national healthcare reports can provide more detailed insights into current performance establish the value of closing gaps in quality and equity and project the time required to bridge those gaps at the current pace of improvement
