an essential collection that constructs the arguments of similarity and difference dividing and uniting women in recent years identity has come to be seen as a process rather than a fact or deterministic force yet recognizable identity traits continue to draw people together and provide them with a sense of empowering commonality although the plasticity afforded identity has freed up rigid definitions and guidelines for affiliation some believe that nebulous demarcations of identity may deprive women of a solid position from which to effectively contest centers of power bringing together articles by well known authors and theorists such as audre lorde june jordan daphne patai barbara smith marilyn frye shane phelan leila j rupp hazel carby and adrienne rich with lesser known writers and scholars this broad based anthology ranges widely from personal narratives to empirical research the book unpacks issues of race class gender ethnicity sexuality disability and age contributing a mélange of sharp lively perspectives to current debate in a postmodern era of feminism how do women come to identify organize and mobilize themselves within a complex global network of relationships identity politics in the women s movement offers critical examination of the inescapable role of identity in academic and activist feminism and the opportunities challenges and conflicts identity politics pose

in recent years scholars have paid increasing attention to the role of women in development and to non governmental organizations ngos as effective vehicles for change although there are a great many published studies dealing with each of these subjects separately there are few on ngos and their work with women studies that combine a theoretic

throughout the cold war soviet citizens had limited access to us life and culture amerika a glossy russian language magazine similar to life provided a rare exception produced by the united states information agency usia america s first peacetime propaganda organization amerika was used to influence the soviet public and convince women in particular that an american style consumer culture and conservative gender norms could better their lives winning women s hearts and minds relies on usia archives issues of amerika and american women s magazines such as the ladies home journal to show how during the postwar period usia officials deployed idealized images of american women as happy fulfilled and feminine wives mothers and homemakers this study analyses how amerika was used to appeal to sovietwomen portrayed in the us media as babushkas they were considered unfeminine overworked and deprived of consumer goods and services by a

repressive regime diana cucuz provides a gendered analysis of the usia and of amerika whose propaganda campaign relied heavily on postwar conservative gender norms and images of domestic contentment to convey positive messages about the american way of life in the hopes of undermining the soviet regime winning women s hearts and minds sheds light on the significance of women gender and consumption to international politics during the cold war

this exhaustive exploration of the sociocultural political and economic roles of african women through history demonstrates how african women have shaped and continue to shape their societies women play essential critical roles in every society african women south of the sahara are certainly no different women s roles in sub saharan africa adds significantly to our understanding of the ways in which women contribute to the fabric of human civilization this book provides an in depth exploration of african women s roles in society from precolonial periods to the contemporary era topical sections describe the roles that women play in family courtship and marriage religion work literature and arts and government each of the six chapters has been structured to elucidate women s roles and functions in society as partners as active participants as defenders of their status and occupations and as agents of change authors nana akua amponsah and toyin falola present a thought provoking work that looks at the complicated victimhood powerful female paradigm in women and gender studies in africa and challenge ideological interest in african historiography that privilege male representation
