written by one of the world s leading authorities on close relationships this accessible study is one of the first to look seriously at what science can tell us about love sex and friendship

shows how we must make deep changes to complete our paradigm shift from the old mechanistic worldview to the new organic worldview reveals the distinct stages of paradigm shifts through the ages including the 18th century enlightenment and the critical stage of our current shift explains how the new organic worldview began with goethe and kant offers solutions for each of us to be able to realize and make the deep changes needed for global regeneration in global awakening michael schacker shows that hidden within our global crises is a positive future for the planet sharing his 30 years of intensive research into the history of change as well as the evolution of consciousness and regenerative science schacker explains how our current shift from the old mechanistic worldview to a new organic worldview based on biological models follows the same pattern as other paradigm shifts across history including the 18th century enlightenment and the american revolution he

reveals the creative geniuses who have contributed to the birth of the organic worldview beginning with goethe kant and hahnemann exposing the scientific and social forces that drive paradigm shifts he details the stages every paradigm shift progresses through the early enlightenment the conservative backlash the intensive phase and and the transformational phase leading to the organic shift explaining that we are currently in the throes of the paradigm flip the critical last phase of our paradigm shift schacker shows how the mechanistic worldview is crumbling around us and nothing but a complete transformation in the way we think will keep us from the path of total self destruction providing a map to overcome the allure of the simplistic mechanical model that has spawned countless unsustainable practices and problems from global warming to intense economic disparities the author offers concrete solutions showing how each of us can use our talents skills and time to make the deep changes needed for global regeneration

this volume considers the ways in which educational research is being shaped by policy across the globe policy effects on research are increasingly influential as policies in and beyond education drive the formation of a knowledge based economy by supporting increased international competitiveness through more effective evidence based interventions in schooling education and training systems what consequences does this increased steering have for research in education how do transnational agencies make their influence felt on educational research how do national systems and traditions of educational research and relations with policy respond to these new pressures what effects does it have on the quality of research and on the freedom of researchers to pursue their own agendas the 2006 volume of the world yearbook of education explores these issues focusing on three key themes globalising policy and research in education steering education research in national contexts global local politics of education research the 2006 volume has a truly global reach incorporating transnational policy perspectives from the oecd and the european commission alongside national cases from across the world in contrasting contexts that include north and south america canada france singapore china russia and new zealand the range of contributions reflect how pervasive these developments are how much is new in this situation and to what extent evidence based policy pressures on research in education build on past relationships between education and policy this book considers the impact of the steering processes on the work and identities of individual researchers and considers how research can be organised to play a more active role in the politics of the knowledge economy and learning society

most scholars would agree that there is an epochal threshold between the world of the middle ages and the modern world agreement on the nature and dynamic structure of that threshold is harder to come by hans blumenberg s original and compelling account of the transition from medieval to modern given in his 1966 work the legitimacy of the modern age has received wide attention elizabeth brient begins her own account of the transition with an extensive critical assessment of central aspects of blumenberg s work she elucidates his dialogical method of historical explanation then discusses the shortcomings of his defense of the legitimacy of modernity the transition to the modern world is marked by the process of making infinite the finite medieval cosmos whereas blumenberg focused on the spatial infinitization of the universe brient claims that the process must be understood intensively as well as extensively in the now infinite universe of the new science the problem of finding a measure for man s self assertive activity and for human knowledge comes to the fore the

second half of the book focuses on the way in which this difficulty is addressed with conceptual resources developed in the tradition of late medieval neoplatonism in particular in the speculative thought of meister eckart and nicholas of cusa specific attention is given to the way in which cusanus notion of the immanence of the infinite in the finite responds to the need for a regulative ideal for human knowing this is the first book length treatment of blumenberg to appear in english and will be a most welcome resource for readers engaged by debates concerning the status of modernity it will be of equal interest to students of eckhart and cusanus and to those generally concerned with the transition between the medieval and the modern world about the author elizabeth brient is assistant professor of philosophy at the university of georgia praise for the book blumenberg could not have wished for a more reverent critique of his achievements or a more exacting textual exegesis regarding the sources of their philosophical content all written in a lucid style that is forthright in the defense of the depth of thought during the middle ages but also pleasing in its subtle irony with respect to blumenberg s and the author s own metaphysical creed walter f veit speculum brient s analysis of blumenberg s philosophy sheds significant light in the debate concerning modernity albrecht classen university of arizona german studies review

vinod acharya presents a new existential interpretation of nietzsche s philosophy he contends that nietzsche s peculiar form of existentialism can be understood only by undertaking a thorough analysis of his characterization and critique of metaphysics this reading remedies the shortcomings of previous existential interpretations of nietzsche which typically view existentialism as concerned primarily with the meaning of individual existence and therefore necessarily at odds with the abstraction and objectivity of metaphysical thought acharya argues that the approach of nietzsche s philosophy especially in his mature works is to make the typical existential position foundational and then to develop to the fullest the implications of this position this meta existential approach necessarily yields an ambiguous and open ended critique of metaphysics taking issue with the heideggerian the poststructuralist and the naturalistic interpretations this book contends that nietzsche

neither simply overcomes metaphysics nor remains trapped within its confines acharya argues that an ever renewed encounter with and critique of metaphysics is an essential aspect of nietzsche s meta existentialism

a former nasa scientist shares a behind the scenes history of the apollo space program and the fight to include science activities in the missions in 1961 president kennedy set a goal of putting a man on the moon in order to assert american dominance in the escalating cold war the mission's sole purpose was to beat the soviets to the punch so how did science get aboard the apollo rockets and what did scientists do with the space allotted to them donald a beattie served at nasa from 1963 to 1973 in several management positions including as program manager of apollo lunar surface experiments in taking science to the moon beattie takes readers inside nasa headquarters and the struggle to include science payloads and lunar exploration as part of the apollo program
