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this book exposes how inequalities based on class and social background arise from employment practices in the digital age it considers instances where social media is used in recruitment to infiltrate private lives and hide job advertisements based on locality where algorithms assess socio economic data to filter candidates where human interviewers are replaced by artificial intelligence with design that disadvantages users of classed language and where already vulnerable groups become victims of

digitalisation and remote work the author examines whether these practices create risks of discrimination based on certain protected attributes including social origin in international labour law and laws in australia and south africa social condition and family status in laws within canada and others the book proposes essential law reform and improvements to workplace policy

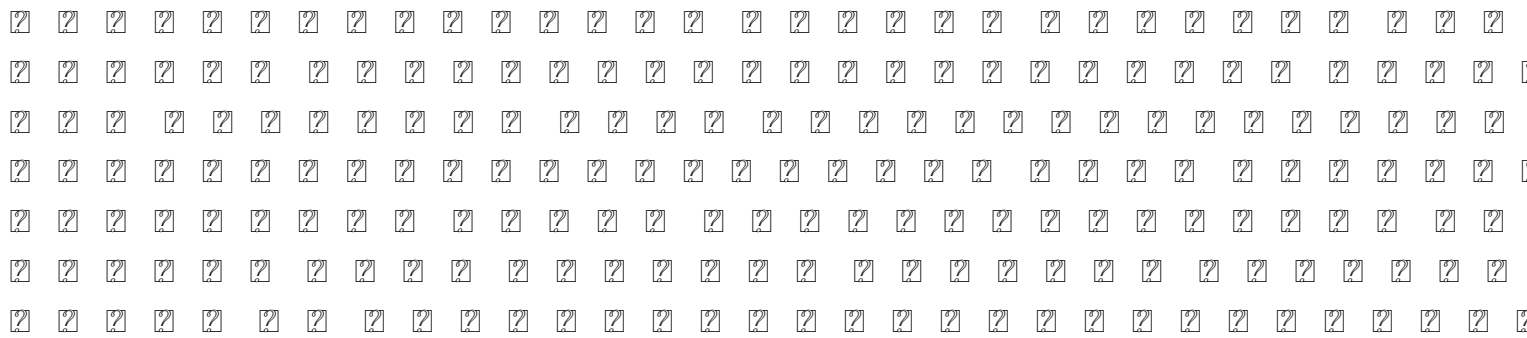
