this book addresses contemporary discourses on a wide variety of topics related to the ideological and epistemological changes of the 19th 20th and 21st centuries and the ways in which they have shaped the spanish language and cultural manifestations in both spain and hispanic america the majority of the chapters are concerned with otherness in its various dimensions the alien other foreign immigrant ethnically different disempowered female or minor as well as the other of different sexual orientation and or ideology following octavio paz otherness is expressed as the attempt to find the lost object of desire the frustrating endeavour of the androgynous plato wishing to embrace the other half of zeus who in his wrath tore off from him otherness compels human beings to search for the complement from which they were severed thus a male joins a female his other half the only half that not only fills him but which allows him to return to the unity and reconciliation which is restored in its own perfection formerly altered by divine will as a result of this transformation one can annul the distance that keeps us away from that which not being our own turns into a source of anguish the clashing diversity of all things requires the human predisposition to accept that which is different such a predisposition is an expression of epistemological ethical and political aperture the disposition to co exist with the different is imagined in the de anthropocentricization of the bonds with all living realms and otherness is in some way the reflection of sameness mismidad the other is closely related to the self because the vision of the other implies a reflection about the self it implies consciously or not a relationship with the self these topics are addressed in this book from an interdisciplinary perspective encompassing arts humanities and social sciences

as different historians have outlined memories and identities stemming from the dreadful events unfolded in europe during the 20th century are deeply connected with the ways in which traumatic and violent pasts are remembered commemorated and mourned as the years go by

collective and national identities during the second half of the last century haven been constructed upon the remembrance and depiction of victims within public sphere as a result the ways in which contemporary violence is framed through the different mediations and re meditations provided by cultural memory are key to understand the reconfiguration of contemporary european identities undoubtedly the experience of terrorism in european soil is one of comes to the fore when dealing the remembrance of violence regardless of the political nature and grounding of the different terrorist attacks which have shocked and undermined the feeling of security within western societies the evolution of european identities is dependent on how such events are depicted and on how their victims are remembered and commemorated echoing this situation remembering terror aims at offering a diverse set of perspectives focusing on different historical cases of remembering and commemorating terrorism in contemporary europe therefore each chapter included in this book is thus intended to provide a different approach to how a specific event in europe related to terrorism has been reframed in this regard far from endorsing a particular perspective remembering terror is bound to offer a glimpse on the heterogeneous ways in which memory of terrorism has reshaped collective identities in europe

a thoroughly researched and documented study of catalan literature under the franco regime focussed on several key post civil war novels and their authors during the 1950s and 1960s several key catalan authors set about rewriting some of their narrative work despite the obstacles to publication in catalan under the franco regime this study describes the social political and cultural conditions that impelled salvador espriu xavier benguerel sebastià juan arbó and joan sales to revise laia el testament tino costa and incerta glòria concentrating particularly on the linguistic debates and literary trends from the 1950s to the early 1970s drawing on a wide range of theoretical perspectives this book examines the reasons for the rewriting including censorship and self censorship generational and ideological changes within the catalan literary field controversies over linguistic purism the appearance of new literary trends and gender and political issues it focuses on the re construction of a distinctive national identity and the impact of repression memory exile and silence on the representation of the war and the post war periods this study explores not only how writers or society at large were affected by the dictatorship but how the armed conflict left its mark on the writing process itself jordi cornellà detrell is a lecturer in spanish in the school of modern languages at bangor university

previous critical studies have focused on feminist approaches to janes s oeuvre this study seeks to expand those discussions through an analysis of the aesthetics of cultural otherness rather than simply gendered otherness within janes s prolific literary production

cultural practices of victimhood aims to set the agenda for a cultural study of victimhood words such as victim and victimhood represent shifting cultural signifiers their meaning depending on the cultural context of their usage using case studies and through a practice based approach questions are asked about how victimhood is defined and constructed whether in the ritual commemoration of refugees on lampedusa the artistic practices of an aboriginal artist such as richard bell or the media practices associated with police violence consisting of contributions by cultural studies experts with an interest in victim studies this book seeks a double readership on the one hand it intends to break new ground with regards to a cultural turn in the field of criminology in particular victimology on the other hand it also seeks to open up discussions about a victimological turn in culture studies the volume invites scholars and advanced students active in both domains to reflect on victimhood in cultural practices

the red brigades were a far left terrorist group in italy formed in 1970 and active all through the 1980s infamous around the world for a campaign of assassinations kidnappings and bank robberies intended as a concentrated strike against the heart of the state the red brigades most notorious crime was the kidnapping and murder of italy s former prime minister aldo moro in 1978 in the late 1990s a new group of violent anticapitalist terrorists revived the name red brigades and killed a number of professors and government officials like their german counterparts in the baader meinhof group and today s violent political and religious extremists the red brigades and their actions raise a host of questions about the motivations ideologies and mind sets of people who commit horrific acts of violence in the name of a utopia in the first english edition of a book that has won critical acclaim and major prizes in italy alessandro orsini contends that the dominant logic of the red brigades was essentially eschatological focused on purifying a corrupt world through violence only through revolutionary terror brigadists believed could humanity be saved from the putrefying effects of capitalism and imperialism through a careful study of all existing documentation produced by the red brigades and of all existing scholarship on the red brigades orsini reconstructs a worldview that can be as seductive as it is horrifying orsini has devised a micro sociological

theory that allows him to reconstruct the group dynamics leading to political homicide in extreme left and neonazi terrorist groups this subversive revolutionary feedback theory states that the willingness to mete out and suffer death depends in the last analysis on how far the terrorist has been incorporated into the revolutionary sect orsini makes clear that this political religious concept of historical development is central to understanding all such self styled purifiers of the world from thomas müntzer s theocratic dream to pol pot s cambodian revolution all the violent purifiers of the world have a clear goal to build a perfect society in which there will no longer be any sin and unhappiness and in which no opposition can be allowed to upset the universal harmony orsini s book reconstructs the origins and evolution of a revolutionary tradition brought into our own times by the red brigades

this book analyzes the formation of a mass anarchist movement in spain over the turn of the twentieth century in this period the movement was transformed from a dislocated collection of groups and individuals into the largest organized body of anarchists in world history the anarcho syndicalist national confederation of labour confederación nacional del trabajo cnt at the same time anarchist cultural practices became ingrained in localities across the whole of spain laying foundations which maintained the movement s popular support until the end of the spanish civil war in 1939 the book shows that grassroots print culture was central to these developments driving the development of ideology and strategy broadly defined as terrorism education and workplace organization and providing an informal structure to a movement which shunned recognized leadership and bureaucracy this study offers a rich analysis of the cultural foundations of spanish anarchism this emphasis also challenges claims that the movement was exceptional or peculiar in its formation by situating it alongside other decentralized bottom up mobilizations across historical and contemporary contexts from the radical pamphleteering culture of the english civil war to the use of social media in the arab spring
