stuttering and cluttering provides a comprehensive overview of both theoretical and treatment aspects of disorders of fluency stuttering also known as stammering and the lesser known cluttering the book demonstrates how treatment strategies relate to the various theories as to why stuttering and cluttering arise and how they develop uniquely it outlines the major approaches to treatment alongside alternative methods including drug treatment and recent auditory feedback procedures part one looks at different perspectives on causation and development emphasizing that in many cases these apparently different approaches are inextricably intertwined part two covers the assessment diagnosis treatment and evaluation of stuttering and cluttering in addition to chapters on established approaches there are sections on alternative therapies including drug therapy and auditory feedback together with a

chapter on counselling reference is made to a number of established treatment programs but the focus is on the more detailed description of specific landmark approaches these provide a framework from which the reader may not only understand others treatment procedures but also a perspective from which they can develop their own offering a clear accessible and comprehensive account of both the theoretical underpinning of stammering therapy and its practical implications the book will be of interest to speech language therapy students as well as qualified therapists psychologists and to those who stutter and clutter

how can managers motivate their employees after conducting detailed field studies of work groups in settings as diverse as insurance company offices and regatta sailboats judith komaki has identified two key behaviours that seem to distinguish effective from ineffective managers monitoring workers performance and communicating consequences drawing on her research over the last ten years komaki combines behavioural and cognitive theories of leadership and puts forward a new model for the study of leadership from an operant perspective

early in this century most empirically oriented psychologists believed that all motivation was based in the physiology of a set of non nervous system tissue needs the theories of that era reflected this belief and used it in an attempt to explain an increasing number of phenomena it was not until the 1950s that it became irrefutably clear that much of human motivation is based not in these drives but rather in a set of innate psychological needs their physiological basis is less understood and as concepts these needs lend themselves more easily to psycho logical than to physiological theorizing the convergence of evidence from a variety of scholarly efforts suggests that there are three such needs self determination competence and interpersonal relatedness this book is primarily about self determination and competence with particular emphasis on the former and about the processes and structures that relate to these needs the need for interpersonal relat edness while no less important remains to be explored and the findings from those explorations will need to be integrated with the present theory to develop a broad organismic theory of human motivation thus far we have articulated self determination theory which is offered as a working theory a theory in the making to stimulate the research that will allow it to evolve further we have stated self determination theory in the form of minitheories that relate to more circumscribed domains and we have developed paradigms for testing predictions from the various minitheories

originally published in 1986 the central topic of this book is the analysis and application of control related beliefs and behaviours for theory and practice in the psychology of aging the volume was written for two specific interrelated purposes aimed at cross fertilization between the psychology of control and the field of gerontology the first purpose was to summarise available research and theory on the psychology of control for researchers and professionals interested in gerontology at the time the second was to enrich the field of the psychology of control

over the last several decades the remarkable success of science and medical technology has allowed many children with chronic illness and handicapping conditions to live longer and healthier lives but this success is not without toll the human cost of chronic illness or a handicapping condition can be enormous for the child and the family for the family there is often the stressful daily burden of care fatigue marital stress low family morale financial burdens and reduced career mobility for the child there are often arduous and painful treatment regimes frequent school absences low energy periods and uncertainties with respect to future education and vocation the course of many diseases is unpredictable and the very fact of chronicity implies ongoing coping problems for the family and the child the impact of a chronic illness or handicapping condition on a family system is usually more disintegrative than integrative disrupting the lives of all family members and exacerbating the developmental risks to the child it is not surprising that a recent comprehensive study for establishing public policies for children with chronic illness at vanderbilt university has called attention to these factors and produced as a primary recommendation increased attention to the psychological impact of disease on the family and the child in this context there is an important need for adequate assessment of psychological and behavioral problems in these children to plan for appropriate services

humor and aging deals with humor throughout the life span although primary attention is given to humor about and by the elderly the book contains theoretical and review material from infancy to old age and includes empirical studies of death and dying in both our own and other societies the book is divided into four parts part i considers theoretical models of humor development across the life span and discusses physiological psychological and sociological processes part ii deals with ways of considering humor and aging from different vantage points these include 1 humor about people of different ages 2 humor for people of different ages and 3 humor by people of different ages part iii addresses the grim subject of death and dying and how it lends itself to humorous treatment in our own and other societies part iv contains brief empirical reports since scientific research in humor and aging is only beginning it seems important to discuss pilot work in hopes that others will follow finally an epilogue by loeb and wood presents a compelling theoretical approach

during the past several decades the field of mental health care has expanded greatly this expansion has been based on greater recognition of the prevalence and treatability of mental disorders as well as the availability of a variety of forms of effective treatment indeed throughout this period our field has witnessed the introduction and the wide spread application of specific pharmacological treatments as well as the development refinement and more broadly based availability of behavioral psychodynamic and marital and family interventions the community mental health center system has come into being and increasing numbers of mental health practitioners from the fields of psychiatry psychology social work nursing and related professional disciplines have entered clinical practice in concert with these developments powerful sociopolitical and socioeconomic forces including the deinstitutionalization movement of the late 1960s and early 1970s and the cost containment responses of the 1980s necessitated by the spiraling cost of health care have shaped the greatest area of growth in the direction of outpatient services this is particularly true of the initial assessment and treatment of nonpsychotic mental disorders which now can often be managed in ambulatory care settings thus we decided that a handbook focusing on the outpatient treatment of mental disorders would be both timely and useful when we first began outlining the contents of this book the third edition of the american psychiatric association s diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm iii was in its fourth year of use

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
