this book uses economic and policy approaches to highlight sustainability environmental and social aspects of the circular economy it emphasizes the circular economy within the market s perspective including the links between consumption and sustainability and how balances between profitability and environmental sustainability can be attained the author also uses a life cycle assessment approach to improve and evaluate circular economy strategies to help determine the environmental social and economic consequences of a product the chapters illustrate circular business models and sustainability consumption behaviour in the public sector while also measuring eco efficiency and sustainability impacts the book will be useful for students and researchers in environmental and sustainability economics as well as businesses and government organizations adapting policies to develop environmentally sustainable economic practices

this book comprehensively examines the financial and economic aspects of the sustainability transitions demanded by the primary components of the european green deal it asks how the eu has been dealing with the allocation of resources to foster the sustainability transition how the additional transformations required by the climate emergency will be financed and which actors businesses governments citizens will pay and how looking at how the eu has been managing this over time through changes in the environment action programmes structural funds or the multiannual financial framework this book examines policy priorities and analyses the different instruments proposed as part of this evolving context including market support instruments for renewable energies and the creation of new instruments such as climate awareness bonds it also highlights new developments such as the debate on the role of environmental taxes or the uneven development across member states of green financial instruments this book presents an evolving puzzle into the limited possibilities of the eu to deploy resources that contribute to the overarching goal of achieving a low carbon economy and illustrates the need for acceptance towards changes and

compromises that are required from all affected stakeholders this book will be of key interest to scholars students and practitioners of sustainable development climate governance and eu politics and more broadly to those working on european studies economics politics international relations or public policy

1 the idea behind the workshop was that of calling attention to the necessity of studying long term tendencies in economic growth we believe that actual growth processes in capitalistic economies are not smooth phenomena and also that the evolution of the economy is characterized by long term fluctuations as well as by trade cycles it is now common place to argue that this point of view was revived after 1973 in consequence of the economic difficulties experienced by industrialized countries while it has a much older origin as its roots can be pushed back at least to the great depression of the 1930 s in preparing this workshop we selected two main approaches as reflected in the title of this book that have been proposed in the last ten years to deal with the causes of long term fluctuations namely the technological or neo schumpeterian approach and the social approach what follows is simply a rough characterization of the existing theoretical positions and it is not meant to be an exhaustive one the interested reader will immediately see that there are many differentiated positions by looking at the arguments contained in each contribution

drawing on a broad transdisciplinary background this book compares distributive justice systems and related socioeconomic institutions within the liberal and sustainable development traditions confronting the capitalist worldview of prominent nobel prize winning economist milton friedman the book offers a theoretical framework for sustainable development a new paradigm of economics grounded in environmental and social issues the analysis takes as its starting point that the development and evolution of human beings is codetermined by socioeconomic institutions these institutions facilitate models of society morality and human behaviour they are all social constructs this matters because the liberal system of justice uses the claim that life is unfair as the justification of socioeconomic inequalities and it is these institutions which determine the concepts of fairness and justice therefore the liberal system's favouring of entrepreneurs should require advance measures to safeguard the interests of the losers instead it seeks to justify their misfortunes it is argued that this liberal notion of fairness can only be fairly executed in conditions of perfect market competition which have never existed in contrast the principles of sustainable development pay attention to the problems generated by the unjust and unfair distribution of resources and postulate wider use of the fairness formula to each according to their needs it is thus more focused on fair ends than on fair procedures this book is addressed to scholars and advanced students in ecological economics environmental economics economics of sustainable development and political science

most public finance books are texts which are aimed at undergraduate or graduate students they are overly technical in nature and appeal only to a narrow range of bureaucrats and academics books on taxation are written for tax practitioners and usually emphasize either what the law is or how to maneuver through the labyrinth of tax law to minimize taxes for clients philosophy books on taxation or public finance simply do not exist the philosophy of taxation and public finance is different it is written in nontechnical language and is aimed to appeal to a wide range of readers including practitioners academics and students in the fields of taxation public finance economics law philosophy and political science as well as general readers who are interested in learning why they are being taxed the way they are the author addresses the major issues and topics in taxation and public finance and injects them with philosophical insights he discusses questions such as what arguments have been used to justify taxation when is tax evasion unethical are some taxes better than others what are the proper functions of government how much is enough is the ability to pay concept valid when can punitive taxes be justified
