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prepared by the nat narcotics intelligence consumers comm presents a comprehensive assessment of the worldwide illicit drug situation the product of a cooperative effort by fed agencies with drug related law enforcement foreign and domestic policy treatment intelligence and research responsibilities covers cocaine esp in bolivia colombia and peru opiates esp mexico asia and russia cannabis incl hashish in pakistan and afghanistan chemicals diversion and dangerous drugs stimulants hallucinogens clandestine labs drug money money laundering process and trends and distribution charts examines organized crime in west africa and its impact on the united states

this annual report from the international narcotics control board gives an extensive analysis of illicit drug abuse and the efforts to control it at the national and international level the 2004 report contains chapters on the following topics the interaction between supply and demand of illicit drugs and the need for integrated reduction strategies the operation of the international drug control system including the national drug control strategy adopted by afghanistan and a review of the world and regional situation in terms of treaty adherence national policies and regional co operation cultivation production trafficking and abuse

in 1988 the united states congress passed laws declaring improbably that the usa would be drug free by 1995 in 1998 the united nations general assembly special session on drugs committed itself to the implausible goal of eradicating the trade in heroin and cocaine within a decade at a time when global heroin production had trebled and global cocaine production had doubled somewhere in australia almost every year for the past quarter century there has been a royal commission or other major official inquiry into the illicit drug industry the australian government spends millions of dollars on attempting to control the illicit drug trade almost 85 per cent of these funds are allocated to law enforcement 5 per cent goes to treatment

and 10 per cent to prevention and research meanwhile the drug industry in australia grows bigger and richer every year and as a result our rates of addiction crime and death continue to rise drugs and democracy examines australia s unsuccessful attempts to control the illicit drug industry and discusses how within the confines of our liberal democratic values and culture we could improve our strategies

examines drug trafficking through central america and the efforts of law enforcement to counter it details the routes methods and networks involved while comparing the evolution of the drug trade in belize coast rica guatemala honduras and panama over three decades provided by publisher

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spanning two volumes of approximately 450 entries in an a to z format this encyclopedia explores the controversial drug war through the lens of varied disciplines a full spectrum of articles explains topics from colombian cartels and mexican kingpins to television reportage from just say no advertising to heroin production and from narco terrorism to more than 500 billion in u s government expenditures key themes cases conferences and conventions countries affecting u s drug policy drug trade and trafficking laws and policies organizations and agencies people presidential administrations treatment and addiction types of drugs

this book meticulously examines how centers of illicit trade pose myriad threats to global security and sustainable development the exponential growth of illicit trade resulting in annual losses amounting to trillions of dollars for the global economy is increasingly concentrated within specific geographic areas these locales serve as safe havens for smugglers and their accomplices fostering a criminal ecosystem that facilitates the

convergence of various criminal activities the book underscores the detrimental impact of poorly regulated international free trade zones which prioritize expediency over security thereby allowing illicit trade to flourish in regions characterized by opaque governance and lax regulatory oversight it comprehensively explores the spectrum of illicit trade present in notorious hubs such as the argentina brazil paraguay tri border area dubai panama belize guatemala and ukraine emphasizing the phenomenon of crime convergence associated with these hubs the book offers actionable recommendations for disrupting their interconnected illicit supply chains infrastructures and networks by addressing this interconnectedness the book fills a critical void in understanding how vulnerabilities within the global economy fuel the creation of illicit trade hubs it will be of great value to researchers in the fields of trade economics criminology and international development it will also be an excellent resource for government agencies policymakers and private sector managers in those industries most affected by the growing problem of illicit trade
