with a few notable exceptions historians have tended to ignore the role that science and medicine played in the antebellum south the fourteen essays in science and medicine in the old south help to redress that neglect by considering scientific and medical developments in the early nineteenth century south and by showing the ways in which the south s scientific and medical activities differed from those of other regions the book

is divided into two sections the essays in the first section examine the broad background of science in the south between 1830 and 1860 the second section addresses medicine specifically the essays frequently counterpoint each other in the first section ronald numbers and janet numbers argue that the south's failure to keep pace with the north in scientific areas resulted from demographic factors william scarborough asserts that slavery produced a social structure that encouraged agricultural and political careers rather than scientific and industrial ones charles dew offers a strong indictment of slavery suggesting that the conservative influence of the institution severely discouraged the adoption of modern technologies other essays examine institutions of higher learning in the south southern scientific societies and the relationship between science and theology the section on medicine in the old south also examines the ways in which the medical needs and practices of the old south were both similar to and distinct from those of other regions k david patterson argues that slavery in effect imported african diseases into the southeast and created a modified west african disease environment james h cassedy points out that land management policies determined by slavery land clearing soil exhaustion also helped create a distinctive disease environment other contributors discuss southern public health problems domestic medicine slave folk beliefs and the special medical needs of blacks science and medicine in the old south is a long overdue examination of these segments of the southern cultural milieu these essays will do much to clarify misconceptions about the time and the region moreover they suggest directions for future research

the authors of the new testament regularly quote and allude to old testament passages that point to the presence person and work of jesus jesus himself claimed that moises wrote about him john 5 46 and on the road to emmaus jesus instructed the disciples from moises and all the prophets regarding himself luke 24 27 though christians affirm that the old testament bears witness to christ how the old testament writers did this is a matter of extensive debate furthermore christian biblical scholars also debate the degree to which contemporary interpreters of the bible can follow the hermeneutics of the new testament authors in using the old testament to point to the person and work of jesus christ five views on christ in the old testament is the first book to bring together in conversation the major views on how the old testament points to christ contributors and views include the first testament priority view john goldingay the christotelic view tremper longman iii the redemptive historical christocentric view jason derouchie the reception centered intertextual view havilah dharamraj the premodern view craig carter each contributor presents their preferred methodology showing readers how their interpretive approach best explains the biblical data additionally authors provide case studies of various old testament passages that equip readers to better compare the strengths and weaknesses of each of author's approaches this essential resource will help readers learn practical steps to help them read the old testament more faithfully as it testifies to jesus the messiah

prophetic oracles of salvation in the old testament is a comprehensive and innovative assessment of these often ignored or misunderstood canonical texts claus westermann shows that these oracles occur in distinct forms and make up a coherent tradition he goes on to demonstrate that these texts often perceived only as a message of judgement and doom in fact proclaim hope and deliverance as well

following the theology of mission developed by John Wesley thousands of men and women have engaged in domestic and international missions but why did they go why do they continue to go today in the use of the Old Testament in a Wesleyan theology of mission Gordon Snider examines the Wesleyan understanding of mission in the light of the Old Testament what theology from God's Old Covenant gave Wesleyans their drive to impact nations and how did it shape their missionary strategies drawing upon a range of primary sources he examines how a number of influential speakers in the Wesleyan tradition particularly the founders and spokespeople of the nineteenth and the early twentieth century have used the Old Testament to inform their theology of mission Snider provides an insight into the works of the important theologians Thomas Coke Jabez Bunting Adam Clarke Richard Watson Daniel Whedon and Edmund Cook focusing on the movement of Wesleyan theology from Great Britain to North America Snider analyses how this affected Wesleyan ideas of holiness eschatology and divine healing readers of this volume will discover why Wesleyan Christians go into the world and gain a deeper understanding of missions

this collection of essays focuses on divination across the ancient world from early Mesopotamia to late antiquity the authors deal with the forms theory and poetics of this important and still poorly understood ancient phenomenon

the Old Testament offers a rich palette of ideas images and narratives that help us unpack some of the more compact and opaque theological ideas of the New Testament in conversation with both Christian and Jewish interpreters prominent scholar Gary Anderson explores the exegetical background of key Christian doctrines through a deeper reading of our two testament Bible he illustrates that Christian doctrines have an organic connection to biblical texts and that doctrine can clarify meanings in the text that are foreign to modern Western readers Anderson traces the development of doctrine through the history of interpretation discussing controversial topics such as the fall of man creation out of nothing the treasury of merit and the veneration of Mary along the way he demonstrates that church doctrines are more clearly grounded in scripture than modern biblical scholarship has often supposed and that the Bible can define and elaborate the content of these doctrines

in focusing exclusively on the book of Exodus and its constant allusions in the New Testament this new collection of studies seeks both to increase knowledge of the textual transmission of Exodus in the first century and to encourage further methodological reflection on the use of scripture vs scriptural traditions as employed by ancient authors first exploring the role of Exodus within Judaism in the Second Temple period the contributors then reflect upon the rhetorical impact of Exodus citations and allusions in the New Testament by taking the reader from the four gospels through the Pauline and disputed letters and Hebrews and all the way to Revelation itself this volume demonstrates both the unity and the diversity of appeals to Exodus traditions in Jewish and Christian literature within the Second Temple period

first published in 1988 can you name the seven wonders of the ancient world did they even exist the Pharos at Alexandria survived into the middle ages but the hanging gardens of Babylon exist only in references by ancient authors and the Colossus of Rhodes if too improbable to have existed in the form and place traditionally ascribed to it

during the twentieth century medicine has been radically transformed and powerfully transformative in 1900 western medicine was important to philanthropy and public health but it was marginal to the state the industrial economy and the welfare of most individuals it is now central to these aspects of life our prospects seem increasingly dependent on the progress of bio medical sciences and genetic technologies which promise to reshape future generations the editors of medicine in the twentieth century have commissioned over forty authoritative essays written by historical specialists but intended for general audiences some concentrate on the political economy of medicine and health as it changed from period to period and varied between countries others focus on understandings of the body and a third set of essays explores transformations in some of the theatres of medicine and the changing experiences of different categories of practitioners and patients

the author of hebrews is arguing that god himself has brought about the fulfillment of these institutions through his son s priesthood his once for all sacrifice and the new covenant he inaugurated in the last days these new institutions are never denied the jews in fact the context of the epistle presumes that these are primarily for the jews considering that the author was speaking to a jewish christian community the author is not arguing for the abandonment by god of the jewish people but rather for the abandonment of the shadowy means by which god s people drew near to him it is here we can speak of a qualified supersessionism according to the author of hebrews the levitical priesthood the mosaic covenant and the levitical sacrifices have been superseded by jesus priesthood the new covenant and jesus once for all sacrifice however we conclude that the polemical passages in hebrews do not promote hatred of the jews nor do they advocate the destruction of the jewish people rather the author of hebrews stresses the fulfillment of specific jewish institutions for the benefit of the jews it is this idea of fulfillment that rules out the charge that the epistle promotes the supercession of the jewish people because of god s great love for his people he has provided a superior way by which his people can draw near to him from the conclusion

the church builders of the middle ages treated the architecture of ancient rome like a quarry full of prefabricated building materials this resulted in some very eclectically and ingeniously constructed churches in the spolia churches of rome we learn of the principles for the distribution of these antique architectural elements and the significance of breaking down and building on the past also presented here is a selection of eleven particularly beautiful churches featuring a wide variety of spolia this book also contains maps and other practical information which make it the ideal companion when seeking out the past in modern day rome

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
