since the energy crisis of 1973 the political economic and strategic importance of the persian gulf to u s interests has become readily apparent yet little has been written on the area or on policy considerations toward it this book in its second updated edition fills a considerable part of the gap in the literature the first chapter desc

gregory gause s masterful book is the first to offer a comprehensive account of the international politics in the persian gulf across nearly four decades the story begins in 1971 when great britain ended its protectorate relations with the smaller states of the lower gulf it traces developments in the region from the oil revolution of 1973 4 through the iranian revolution the iran iraq war and the gulf war of 1990 1 to the toppling of saddam hussein in the american led invasion of iraq in 2003 bringing the story of gulf regional politics up to 2008 the book highlights transnational identity issues regime security and the politics of the world oil market and charts the changing mix of interests and ambitions driving american policy the author brings his experience as a scholar and commentator on the gulf to this riveting account of one of the most politically volatile regions on earth

provides an account of the discovery of oil in the persian gulf and the tension between domestic forces and international companies over the ownership of these resources then examines price fluctuations from 1973 to 1998 analyzes dynamics of both demand and supply policies and demonstrates the unique characteristics of the gulf that will keep it as the major player in the oil industry well into the 21st century argues that the north sea and caspian basin cannot replace the gulf as the dominant player in energy politics

this work gives a background to the historical and geographical settings in the persian gulf and instances of settled continental shelf boundaries in the region and to the 2 most complicated instances of maritime territory and boundary issues

exploring the history of the persian gulf from ancient times until the present day leading authorities treat the internal history of the region and describe the role outsiders have played there the book focuses on the unity and identity of gulf society and how the gulf historically has been part of a cosmopolitan indian ocean world

the persian gulf important because of its vast energy resources emerged into the limelight of geopolitics at the time of the british labour government s policy of withdrawal from east of suez in 1968 before 1968 it had been recognised that the gulf lay in the legitimate sphere of influence of britain while the united states exerted its influence in the two pivotal littoral states of iran and saudi arabia the soviets had been gaining influence in iraq ever since the overthrow of the monarchy in 1958 and the chinese were also fishing for influence by their support of the popular front for the liberation of the arabian gulf this book examines the political axes of the various super powers with iran and the persian gulf and discusses the implications of these problems for the issue of security in the region

this sweeping history reorients our understanding of the middle east placing the gulf at the heart of globalized trade and cross cultural encounters world history began in the persian gulf the ancient port cities that dotted its coastlines created the first global seaboard a place from where faiths and cultures from around the world set sail and made contact more than a history the center of the world shows us that contradictions that define our modern age have always been present for over four thousand years the gulf sometimes called the persian gulf sometimes the arabian gulf has been a global crossroads while managing to avoid control by the world s greatest empires in its history we see a world of rapid change fluctuating centers of trade a dependency on uncertain global markets and intense cross cultural encounters that hold a mirror to the contemporary world focusing each chapter on a different port around the gulf the center of the world shows how the people of the gulf adapted to larger changes in world history creating a system of free trade merchant rule and commerce that continues to define the region today

for much of the contemporary history of the middle east the persian gulf has stood at the center of the region s strategic significance at the same time the gulf has been wracked by political instability and tension as far back as the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries britain zeroed in on the persian gulf as a critical passageway to its crown jewel india and entered into protectorate agreements with local ruling families thus bestowing on them international legitimacy and eventually the resources and support necessary to ascend to kingships today the region is undergoing profound changes that range from rapid economic and infrastructural development to tumultuous social and cultural transformations far from eroding the area s political significance these changes have only accentuated rivalries and tensions and have brought to the forefront new challenges to international security and stability together the essays in this volume present a comprehensive detailed and accessible account of the international politics of the region focusing on the key factors that give the persian gulf its strategic significance contributors look at the influence of vast deposits of oil and natural gas on international

politics the impact of the competing centers of power of iran and saudi arabia the nature of relationships among countries within the persian gulf and the evolving interaction between islam and politics throughout the collection issues of internal and international security are shown to be central drawing on the comprehensive knowledge and experience of experts in the region the international politics of the persian gulf shines a bright light on this area offering insights and thoughtful analyses on the critical importance of this troubled region to global politics

the position of the persian gulf as the main highway between east and west has long given this region special significance both within the middle east and in global affairs more generally this book examines the history of international relations in the gulf since the 1820s as great powers such as britain and the us and regional powers such as iran and iraq vied for supremacy over this geopolitically vital region it focuses on the struggle for control over the islands of the gulf in particular the three islands of abu musa greater tunb and lesser tunb an issue that remains highly contentious today it describes how for 170 years britain eroded iranian influence in the gulf both directly by asserting colonial rule over iranian islands and port districts and also through claiming iranian islands for their protégés on the arab littoral it shows how after britain s withdrawal these islands became a pawn in the animosity and conflict that pitted at one time arab radicals and nationalists against monarchical iran and later the conservative moderate arab camp against islamic iran it goes on to explore the impact of the rise of american power in the gulf since the start of the 1990s its policy of containment of iran and iraq and how this has provided encouragement to the ambitions of the persian gulf arab littoral states especially the uae towards the islands of the gulf

this book explores the historiography ports and peoples of the persian gulf over the past two centuries offering a more inclusive history of the region than previously available restoring the history of minority communities which until now have been silenced the book provides a corrective to the official story put forward by modern states

this text examines the causes and consequences of each of those dynamics both individually and collectively that have made this small waterway and its surrounding areas one of the most volatile and tension filled regions in the world this pervasive insecurity the book argues is largely a product of four interrelated developments

this book is a collection of the notes of s b miles longtime british official in the persian gulf and covers pre islamic history pointing out that the inhabitants were masters of maritime commerce where trade included slaves spices gold precious stones and textiles from asia and africa

in the direction of the persian gulf 1977 analyses the soviet union s interest in the countries of the persian gulf against the background of its relations with the arab world and the complexities of power politics it examines from the nineteenth century to the present russia s involvement in and efforts to gain at least a foothold if not control of this oil rich region particular attention is paid to the soviet s interest in persian gulf oil and russian fuel resources are also discussed although bilateral and multilateral local relations are closely examined power politics in general and in the region and the indian ocean are not neglected in addition to soviet sources the authors have used the arab and western press periodicals and monitoring services extensively

this book analyzes the origins of conflicts and wars in the persian gulf assesses the common factor s that have been their essential fuel determines their fallout for the political economic and human development of the region and provides insight into how they may be better contained

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
