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this sweeping history of the roman empire from 44 bc to ad 235 has three purposes to describe what was happening in the central administration and in the entourage of the emperor to indicate how life went on in italy and the provinces in the towns in the countryside and in the army camps and to show how these two different worlds impinged on each other colin wells s vivid account is now available in an up to date second edition

during the principate roughly from 27 bc to ad 235 when the empire reached its maximum extent roman society and culture were radically transformed but how was the vast territory of the empire controlled did the demands of central government stimulate economic growth or endanger survival what forces of cohesion operated to balance

the social and economic inequalities and high mortality rates how did the official religion react in the face of the diffusion of alien cults and the emergence of christianity these are some of the many questions posed here in an expanded edition of the original pathbreaking account of the society economy and culture of the roman empire as an integrated study of the life and outlook of the ordinary inhabitants of the roman world it deepens our understanding of the underlying factors in this important formative period of world history additions to the second edition include an introductory chapter which sets the scene and explores the consequences for government and the governing classes of the replacement of the republic by the rule of emperors a second extra chapter assesses how far rome's subjects resisted her hegemony addenda to the chapters throughout offer up to date bibliography and point to new evidence and approaches which have enlivened roman history in recent decades

in this lively and very readable history of the roman empire from its establishment in 27 bc to the barbarian incursions and the fall of rome in ad 476 kershaw draws on a range of evidence from juvenal s satires to recent archaeological finds he examines extraordinary personalities such as caligula and nero and seismic events such as the conquest of britain and the establishment of a new rome at constantinople and the split into eastern and western empires along the way we encounter gladiators and charioteers senators and slaves fascinating women bizarre sexual practices and grotesque acts of brutality often seen through eyes of some of the world s greatest writers he concludes with a brief look at how rome lives on in the contemporary world in politics architecture art and literature

the rise of christianity during the first four centuries of the common era was the pivotal development in western history and profoundly influenced the later direction of all

world history yet for all that has been written on early christian history the primary sources for this history are widely scattered difficult to find and generally unknown to lay persons and to historians not specially trained in the field in christianity and the roman empire ralph novak interweaves these primary sources with a narrative text and constructs a single continuous account of these crucial centuries the primary sources are selected to emphasize the manner in which the government and the people of the roman empire perceived christians socially and politically the ways in which these perceptions influenced the treatment of christians within the roman empire and the manner in which christians established their political and religious dominance of the roman empire after constantine the great came to power in the early fourth century ce ralph martin novak holds a masters degree in roman history from the university of chicago for undergraduates seminarians general audiences
