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truth and method is a landmark work of 20th century thought which established hans georg gadamer as one of the most important philosophical voices of the 20th century in this book gadamer established the field of philosophical

hermeneutics exploring the nature of knowledge the book rejected traditional quasi scientific approaches to establishing cultural meaning that were prevalent after the war in arguing the truth and method acted in opposition to each other gadamer examined the ways in which historical and cultural circumstance fundamentally influenced human understanding it was an approach that would become hugely influential in the humanities and social sciences and remains so to this day in the work of jurgen habermas and many others provided by publisher

in these essays appearing for the first time in english gadamer addresses practical questions about recent politics in europe about education and university reform and about the role of poetry in the modern world this book also includes a series of interviews that the editors conducted in 1986 gadamer elaborates on his experiences in education and politics touching on the collapse of the weimar republic the early frankfurt school heidegger and the nazis university life in east germany and the prospects for europe in the coming years hans georg gadamer was probably heidegger s leading interpreter in germany and in the 1950s and 1960s he became the world s leading exponent of hermeneutics his hermeneutical theory explains how it is that ancient art and philosophy still speak to us today his influential idea of the fusion of horizons also shows how it is that we understand what is remote from our own culture

this volume presents six lively conversations with hans georg gadamer born 1900 one of the twentieth century s master philosophers looking back over his life and thought gadamer takes up key issues in his philosophy addresses points of controversy and replies to his critics including those who accuse him of having been in complicity with the nazis a genial and direct conversationalist gadamer is here captured at his best and most accessible the interviews took place between 1989 and 1996 and all but one appear in english for the first time in this volume the first three conversations conducted by heidelberg philosopher carsten dutt deal with hermeneutics aesthetics and practical philosophy and the question of ethics in a fourth conversation with university of heidelberg classics professor glenn w most gadamer argues for the vital importance of the greeks for our contemporary thinking in the next the philosopher reaffirms his connection with phenomenology and clarifies his relation to husserl and heidegger in a conversation with london philosopher alfons grieder in the final interview with german nazi expert dorte von westernhagen gadamer describes his life

this volume presents carefully selected essays from gadamer's *kleine schriften* the seven essays comprising part 1 contain gadamer's discussion of hermeneutical reflection part 2 consists of six essays dealing with phenomenology existential philosophy and philosophical hermeneutics

philosopher hans georg gadamer has made major contributions to aesthetic theory plato and hegel studies humanistic studies and the philosophy of history a student of martin heidegger gadamer took up and developed a number of central heideggerian insights he also had productive public debates with contemporaries such as emilio betti and jürgen habermas the shape of contemporary hermeneutics is due almost entirely to gadamer's influence and his magnum opus *truth and method* is considered one of the great philosophical works of the twentieth century this book is dedicated to gadamer in honor of his hundredth birthday in 2000 the essays provide a measure of the classical character of gadamer's work by showing the breadth of engagement his ideas have provoked as in gadamer's own life and work dialogue and conversation figure as important themes in all of the essays while they encompass a diversity of philosophical perspectives interests and styles the essays also suggest the ever present possibility of dialogue across language and tradition and of the formation of new modes of discourse and philosophizing

a distinct logic to gadamer's early writings makes them more than mere precursors to the mature thought that appeared in *truth and method* they contain their own new and different philosophical hermeneutics and are worth reading with a fresh eye the young gadamer began his publication career by arguing that plato's ethical writings did not express doctrine but rather depended upon the play of language among speakers in an ethical discourse community this was the key idea of plato's dialectical ethics gadamer's first book following the classical formula of seeing politics as the continuation of ethics gadamer's writings in the 1930s and 1940s concentrated on the platonic idea of the state and argued two key points first the exiling of poets from the city was a way of banishing monologue and clearing the way for a dialogue as the language form appropriate to political discourse communities second the platonic state's defining task was the educational one of shaping the soul and this could not be achieved monologically but rather had to take place as a dialogical play between the educator and the soul the mature philosophical hermeneutics of *truth and method* is a metaphor taken from the literary experience of constructing textual meaning out of the play of parts and whole the philosophical hermeneutics of gadamer's early writings rests

on a play between the ethical whole initially the gestalt figure of the platonic socrates but later the platonic state and the individual soul in need of ethical guidance there is no conflict between the early and the later hermeneutics but the early hermeneutics retain a freshness of spirit and boldness of interpretation that is characteristic of the weimar culture of gadamer's marburg youth from beginning to end gadamer's early writings remind us that plato's dialogues really do record the conversational essence of western philosophy at its birth

hans georg gadamer is one of the leading exponents of hermeneutics with a formidable influence on thinking in the humanities the two main foci of his work have been greek philosophy especially plato and hermeneutics but his influences range through many sources from kant to heidegger this volume contains gadamer's intellectual autobiography essays by leading philosophers gadamer's replies to each essay and a bibliography of gadamer's writings

hans georg gadamer is one of the leading philosophers in the world today his philosophical hermeneutics has had a major impact in a wide range of disciplines including the social sciences literary criticism theology and jurisprudence truth and method his major work is widely recognised to be one of the great classics of twentieth century thought in this book georgia warnke provides a clear and systematic exposition of gadamer's work as well as a balanced and thoughtful assessment of his views warnke gives particular attention to the ways in which gadamer's work has been taken up and criticised by literary critics social theorists and philosophers such as hirsch habermas and rorty she thus provides an introduction to gadamer which demonstrates the relevance of his work to current debates in a variety of disciplines this book will be invaluable to students and specialists throughout the humanities and social sciences as well as to anyone who is interested in the most important developments in contemporary thought

a philosophical and historical testament to the twentieth century this volume consists of a wide ranging series of interviews conducted in 1999 2000 between the then centenarian and his former assistant and associate of over thirty years riccardo dottori these ten dialogues distill and situate gadamer's philosophy in the context of what has arguably been the bloodiest century in human history in the course of the interviews gadamer addresses often critically the work of a wide variety of philosophers including heidegger nietzsche jaspers popper vico habermas

rorty and derrida he also elaborates on german philosophy during the nazi period and in one of the more fascinating conversations we are treated to a glimpse of gadamer s personal perspective on the question of heidegger s nazism including a discussion of the political influence that great philosopher s wife elfirde had on him that tends to contradict most other published accounts with the possible exception of his autobiography 1985 a century of philosophy is perhaps the most accessible expression of gadamer s life and work in english today

hermeneutics between history and philosophy collects together gadamer s remaining important untranslated writings on the problem of history and the major philosophical traditions of the 20th century from the standpoint of hermeneutics in these writings gadamer examines important thinkers as husserl heidegger sartre bourdieu and habermas and their ongoing legacies this volume also includes a preface by the editors who are also the translators presenting the structure of the volume a substantial introduction situating gadamer s particular project and examining the place of hermeneutics vis a vis the disciplines of history and philosophy in the 20th century the translation is followed by a glossary of german terms and greek and latin expressions as well as a bibliography of all the works cited and alluded to by gadamer

this volume begins with an autobiographical sketch and culminates in a conversation with jean grondin that looks back over a lifetime of productive philosophical work

the first english language biography of one of the leading intellectuals of the twentieth century hans georg gadamer 1900 2002 was one of the greatest philosophers of our era he was also at the center of some of the century s darkest most complex historical events for he chose to remain in his native germany in the 1930s neither supporting hitler nor actively opposing him but negotiating instead an unpolitical position that allowed him to continue his philosophical work in this magisterial book jean grondin appraises gadamer s life and achievement drawing on countless interviews with gadamer and his contemporaries gadamer s personal correspondence and extensive archival research grondin traces gadamer s life as an academician and the development of his ideas placing them in the context of his times he sheds light on the genesis and accomplishment of gadamer s major opus truth and method the bible of modern day hermeneutics and he addresses the question of gadamer s attitude and actions amid the catastrophe of nazi germany painting a balanced portrait of a scholar who tried to preserve

german culture and tradition in the face of an invasive menace

hans georg gadamer s theory of hermeneutics is one of the most important modern theories of interpretation and understanding and at its heart is the experience of reading literature in this clear and comprehensive guide to gadamer s thought karl simms presents an overview of gadamer s life and works outlining his importance to hermeneutic theory and its place in literary studies explains and puts into context his key ideas including dialogue phronēsis play tradition and horizon shows how gadamer s ideas have been influential in the interpretation of literary texts explains gadamer s debates with key contemporaries and successors such as habermas ricoeur and derrida provides detailed suggestions for further reading with a significance that crosses disciplinary boundaries from cultural studies literary theory and philosophy through to history music and fine arts gadamer s pioneering work on hermeneutic theory remains of crucial importance to the study of texts in the humanities

the ideas of the german philosopher hans georg gadamer have had considerable influence both in their own right as the leading modern exposition of philosophical hermeneutics and interpreting the works of heidegger plato and hegel this work covers the trail of gadamer s thought taking truth and method 1960 translated 1975 as the axis of the interpretation of gadamer s thought jean grondin lays out the key themes of the work method humanism aesthetic judgement truth the work of history with exemplary clarity gadamer s concerns are situated in the context of traditional philosophical issues showing for example how gadamer both continues and significantly modifies the philosophical problem as it begins with descartes and advances rather than simply follows heidegger s treatment of the relationship of thinking and language in this way grondin shows how the issues of philosophical hermeneutics are relevant for contemporary concerns in science and history

gadamer s hermeneutics and the art of conversation covers the nature of dialogue and understanding in hans georg gadamer s linguistically oriented hermeneutics and its relevance for contemporary philosophy this timely collection of essays stresses the fundamental significance of the other for a further development of heidegger s analytics of dasein by recognizing the priority of the other over oneself gadamerian hermeneutics founds a culture of dialogue sorely needed in our multi cultural globalized community the essays solicited for this volume are presented in three thematic blocks hermeneutic conversation hermeneutics aesthetics and transcendence

hermeneutic ethics education and politics the volume proposes a dynamic understanding of hermeneutics as putting into practice the art of conversation

continuum s guides for the perplexed are clear concise and accessible introductions to thinkers writers and subjects that students and readers can find especially challenging concentrating specifically on what it is that makes the subject difficult to fathom these books explain and explore key themes and ideas guiding the reader towards a thorough and confident understanding of demanding material hans georg gadamer is one of the foremost european philosophers of recent times his work on philosophical hermeneutics defined the whole subject and truth and method his magnum opus is a landmark text in modern philosophy however gadamer s ideas the complex relationship between them and the often opaque way they are expressed undoubtedly pose a considerable challenge for the reader gadamer a guide for the perplexed is the ideal text for anyone trying to get to grips with gadamer s work providing a clear account of the central tenets of gadamer s philosophy the book does not shy away from the more complex material and provides an invaluable thorough and fully engaged account of gadamer s hermeneutics there is clear exposition and analysis of such key terms often problematic for the reader as fusion of horizons effective historical consciousness and the logic of question and answer as well as gadamer s redefinition of such concepts as prejudice authority and tradition the book also discusses gadamer s influence in other areas of philosophy the response of other philosophers to his work and criticisms of his work on the grounds of relativism

the combination of author and subject matter found here makes an unusually interesting text on the continental european philosophy of the twentieth century as heidegger s former student colleague and lifelong friend gadamer offers a particularly insightful commentary on heidegger s thinking not only do the essays focus on heidegger s thought but they also often begin with a description of the philosophical scene in which he first appeared giving the reader a genuine feel for the kind of impact he made but the essays do not leave off in the past rather they lead into the present giving heidegger a voice which continues to have a revolutionary impact the text does not only provide a commentary on heidegger it also provides a fascinating look at gadamer himself the narratives provide us with an intimate look at both the author and his hermeneutics at work and his commentary on heidegger s thought is a commentary on his own thought as well

throughout his long career gadamer wrote and taught widely on the philosophy of the ancient world in this volume moving from the pre socratics to plato gadamer explores the legacy that ancient thought left for such philosophical giants as kant schleiermacher and hegel ancient sources modern appropriations also includes a substantial critical introduction in which the editors reconstruct gadamer s views on how the study of the history of philosophy contributes to the task of doing philosophy by keeping a tradition alive and moving it into the future this final volume of the the selected writings of hans georg gadamer also includes a thorough bibliography of gadamer s available writings in english and key secondary studies of his philosophical hermeneutics available in english for the first time ancient sources modern appropriations is comprised of the most important of gadamer s previously untranslated writings on ancient philosophy

this book engages and clarifies concepts crucial to hans georg gadamer s philosophical hermeneutics including the concepts of effective history tradition dialogue and language festivals of interpretation exhibits the universal scope of hermeneutics the authors respond to three questions often raised about gadamer s philosophical hermeneutics part one takes up the question of how gadamer understands truth it discusses how hermeneutical truth relates to methods how truth may be thought to be historically conditioned without at the same time being relative and how a truthful interpretation can produce a new understanding while simultaneously remaining faithful to the text part two brings out the political legal and social relevance of gadamer s philosophical hermeneutics by focusing on the role interpretation plays in times of political crisis of disputes in constitutional law of changing ideas of societal needs such as health care and of increased technological control of public opinion the last question often asked about gadamer s work concerns its relation to poetry part three treats the challenge posed to philosophy by poetry in general and particularly by the poetry of paul celan as well as questions raised recently by jacques derrida about different ways of thinking about interpretation and text

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
