1274 although unfinished the summa is one of the classics of the history of philosophy and one of the most influential works of
western literature it is intended as an instructional guide for moderate theologians and a compendium of all of the main theological

teachings of the catholic church it presents the reasoning for almost all points of christian theology in the west the summa theologica is divided into three parts and each of these three parts contains numerous subdivisions part 1 deals primarily with god and comprises discussions of 119 questions concerning the existence and nature of god the creation angels the work of the six days of creation the essence and nature of man and divine government part 2 deals with man and includes discussions of 303 questions concerning the purpose of man habits types of law vices and virtues prudence and justice fortitude and temperance graces and the religious versus the secular life part 3 deals with christ and comprises discussions of 90 questions concerning the incarnation the sacraments and the resurrection some editions of the summa theologica include a supplement comprising discussions of an additional 99 questions concerning a wide variety of loosely related issues such as excommunication indulgences confession marriage purgatory and the relations of the saints toward the damned scholars believe that rainaldo da piperno a friend of aquinas probably gathered the material in this supplement from a work that aquinas had completed before he began working on the summa theologica it seeks to describe the relationship between god and man and to explain how man's reconciliation with the divine is made possible at all through christ to this end aquinas cites proofs for the existence of god and outlines the activities and nature of god approximately one half of the summa theologica then examines the nature and purpose of man finally aquinas devotes his attention to the nature of christ and the role of the sacraments in effecting a bridge between god and man within these broad topical boundaries though aquinas examines the nature of god and man in exquisite detail his examination includes questions of how angels act on bodies the union of body and soul the cause and remedies of anger cursing and the comparison of one sin with another aquinas is attempting to offer a truly universal and rational view of all existence thomas aquinas o p 1225 1274 also thomas of aquin or aquino was an italian dominican priest and an immensely influential philosopher and theologian in the tradition of scholasticism within which he is also known as the doctor angelicus doctor

communis and doctor universalis he was the foremost classical proponent of natural theology and the father of thomism his influence on western thought is considerable and much of modern philosophy was conceived in development or refutation of his ideas particularly in the areas of ethics natural law metaphysics and political theory

this is a valuable source book for the idea of rest as it occurs in a wide spectrum of ancient jewish and christian literature the author provides a new way of understanding matt 11 28 30 that challenges most recent scholarship and acts as a guide for application in the church

bloomfield and dunn describe the varying roles which poets have historically filled within society whether ancient medieval or pre modern and identify the key functions of the poet figure he or sometimes she supports the ruler and is in turn rewarded for a central service to the tribe he exercises his authority by an apparently magical understanding of the past present and future and whenever called upon to perform an official rite he knows how to wield the appropriate traditional esoteric utterances in order to illustrate the ways in which this kind of poetic function can be seen to have been exercised in early irish literature pre modern scottish gaelic early welsh early norse and old english the authors draw on a wide range of texts the study concludes with an examination of the implications of their findings for twentieth century readers exploring the utterances of poets remote from them in time or space

the suggestion that the New Testament contains citations of early Christological hymns has long been a controversial issue in New

testament scholarship as a way of advancing this facet of new testament research matthew e gordley examines the colossian hymn col 1 15 20 in light of its cultural and epistolary contexts as a result of a broad comparative analysis he claims that col 1 15 20 is a citation of a prose hymn which represents a fusion of jewish and greco roman conventions for praising an exalted figure a review of hymns in the literature of second temple judaism demonstrates that the colossian hymn owes a number of features to jewish modes of praise likewise a review of hymns in the broader greco roman world demonstrates that the colossian hymn is equally indebted to conventions used for praising the divine in the greco roman tradition in light of these hymnic traditions of antiquity the analysis of the form and content of the colossian hymn shows how the passage fits well into a greco roman context and indicates that it is best understood as a quasi philosophical prose hymn cited in the context of a paraenetic letter finally in view of ancient epistolary and rhetorical theory and practice an analysis of the role of the hymn in colossians suggests that the hymn serves a number of significant rhetorical functions throughout the remainder of the letter
