comparative legal linguistic and genre analysis in order to make the transfer of legal information as precise accurate and comprehensible as possible the primary objective of legal translation is for the target recipient to be provided as explicit extensive and precise legal information in the target language as is contained in the source text complemented by the translator with facts rendering the original information fully comprehensible in the different legal environment and culture a dictionary which will help its users to produce legal texts in the target language should be founded upon a profound comparative legal and linguistic analysis that will a determine equivalents at the levels of vocabulary syntax and genre b select the appropriate lexicographic material to be included in the dictionary and c create entries in a user friendly manner

the shang han lun has been a primary treatment theory and practice source for nearly two millenia its author zhang zhong jing has been named the chinese hippocrates to highlight the depth and breadth of his contribution to traditional chinese drug therapy this edition features the chinese text pinyin transliteration and an english translation of the entire song dynasty text the content and textual order most used in asia just as in chinese language editions it is fully supplemented with notes and commentaries the notes describe the clinical symptoms zhang zhong jing associated with the chinese terms for example modern interpretations of a moderate pulse often refer to the speed of its beats the same term when used in the shang han lun refers to a pulse that is loose soft and harmonious such notes provide practitioners with the clinical observations necessary to properly apply the information the commentaries further enhance the text s clinical utility by explaining the theoretical and practical foundations behind the lines of text because entire bodies of theory and practice can be associated with the terms and expressions used in canonical works like the shang han lun commentaries have become a standard means of knowledge acquisition for asian students the commentaries in this edition serve exactly the same purpose greatly enhancing its utility the introductory matter explains the background of the text the conceptual structure of its contents and the problems of exegesis the appendices are designed to assist those studying chinese and the glossary and the full pinyin english index make this an easily accessed reference

confluences of medicine is the first book length exploration in english of issues of medicine and society in premodern japan this multifaceted study weaves a rich tapestry of buddhist healing practices chinese medical knowledge asian pharmaceuticals and islamic formulas as it elucidates their appropriation and integration into medieval japanese medicine it expands the parameters of the study of medicine in east asia which to date has focused on the subject in individual countries and introduces the dynamics of interaction and exchange that coursed through the east asian macro culture the book explores these themes primarily through the two extant works of the buddhist priest and clinical physician kajiwarashiōzen 1265-1337 who was active at the medical facility housed at gokurakuji temple in kamakura the capital of japan's first warrior government with access to large numbers of printed song medical texts and a wide range of materia medica from as far away as the middle east shōzen was a beneficiary of the efflorescence of trade and exchange across the east china sea that typifies this era his break with the restrictions of japanese medicine is revealed in ton'ishō's book of the simple physician and man'apo's myriad relief formulas both of these texts are landmarks the former being the first work written in japanese for a popular audience the latter the most extensive japanese medical work prior to the seventeenth century confluences of medicine brings to the fore the range of factors networks of buddhist priests institutional support availability of materials relevance of overseas knowledge to local conditions of domestic strife and serendipity that influenced the japanese acquisition of chinese medical information it offers the first substantive portrait of the impact of the song printing revolution in medieval japan and provides a rare glimpse of chinese medicine as it was understood outside of china it is further distinguished by its attention to materia medica and medicinal formulas and to the challenges of technical translation and technological transfer in the reception and incorporation of a new pharmaceutical regime
