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peasant rebellion in a slave society identifies the immediate and remote reasons for the Balaiada revolt in Maranhão Brazil analyzing the special
 characteristics of the region that favored the development of a relatively independent peasantry within and around the cotton rice cassava and cattle
 estates the book explores the demography of Maranhão and patterns of land ownership and documents the rapid degradation of the environment by
 plantation based export agriculture the analysis of various types of coerced and free labor the oligopolistic structure of the colonial economy and the key

determinants of class and status contextualizes the conflict potential in maranhão during the first half of the nineteenth century the people of color as they called themselves and enslaved workers from plantations rose against a white and conservative elite claiming their constitutional rights or their freedom the central government in rio de janeiro had to dispatch considerable amounts of money and troops to defeat the insurrection and subject the province again to imperial rule and enslaved workers and peasants to the plantocracy this richly illustrated volume will be of interest to students and scholars working on slavery in the americas and the atlantic world as well as brazilian history

in brazil and throughout the african diaspora black women especially poor black women are rarely considered leaders of social movements let alone political theorists but in the northeastern city of salvador brazil it is these very women who determine how urban policies are established focusing on the gamboa de baixo neighborhood in salvador s city center black women against the land grab explores how black women s views on development have radicalized local communities to demand justice and social change in black women against the land grab keisha khan y perry describes the key role of local women activists in the citywide movement for land and housing rights she reveals the importance of geographic location for understanding the gendered aspects of urban renewal and the formation of black women led social movements how have black women shaped the politics of urban redevelopment perry asks and what does this kind of political intervention tell us about black women s agency her work uncovers the ways in which political labor at the neighborhood level is central to the mass mobilization of black people against institutional racism and for citizenship rights and resources in brazil highlighting the political life of black communities specifically those in urban contexts often represented as socially pathological and politically bankrupt black women against the land grab offers a valuable corrective to how we think about politics and about black women particularly poor black women as a political force

a comparative examination of black rural communities claims to land and their connections to the broader fight against racism in brazil

peripecias de um pesquisador gringo no brasil nos anos 1960 ou a cata do cordel e um relato divertido e informativo da primeira estada de pesquisa do curran no brasil neste livro o autor conta duas estorias a pesquisa sobre o cordel e talvez mais importante as viagens e a peripecias daquele primeiro ano no brasil os dois relatos sao inseparaveis e se complementam os capitulos incluem recife e o nordeste viagens ao interior do nordeste pesquisa na capital colonial do brasil salvador da bahia pesquisa e turismo no rio de janeiro viagens ao interior desde o rio de janeiro incluindo ouro preto congonhas do campo e uma viagem memoravel em um gaiola ou seja vapor de roda no rio sao francisco em minas gerais e bahia e finalmente pesquisa na bacia amazonica incluindo belem do para e manaus o relato nao esta em linguagem academica mas em um estilo coloquial de conversa curran escreve como se estivesse fazendo um bate papo com o leitor relatando estorias de suas viagens e talvez com o autor e leitor gozando uma caipirinha ou um bom choppe enquanto o autor conta suas estorias

this highly original book opens up the almost entirely neglected area of the black african presence in western europe during the renaissance covering history literature art history and anthropology it investigates a whole range of black african experience and representation across renaissance europe from various types of slavery to black musicians and dancers from real and symbolic africans at court to the views of the catholic church and from writers of african descent to black african criminality their findings demonstrate the variety and complexity of black african life in fifteenth and sixteenth century europe and how it was affected by firmly held preconceptions relating to the african continent and its inhabitants reinforced by renaissance ideas and conditions of enormous importance both for european and american history this book mixes empirical material and theoretical approaches and addresses

such issues as stereotypes changing black african identity and cultural representation in art and literature

the portuguese colonial empire established its base in africa in the fifteenth century and would not be dissolved until 1975 this book investigates how the different populations under portuguese rule were represented within the context of the colonial empire by examining the relationship between these representations and the meanings attached to the notion of race colour for example an apparently objective criterion of classification became a synonym or near synonym for race a more abstract notion for which attempts were made to establish scientific credibility through her analysis of government documents colonial propaganda materials and interviews the author employs an anthropological perspective to examine how the existence of racist theories originating in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries went on to inform the policy of the estado novo second republic 1933 1974 and the production of academic literature on race in portugal this study provides insight into the relationship between the racist formulations disseminated in portugal and the racist theories produced from the eighteenth century onward in europe and beyond

peatlands are transition ecosystems between terrestrial and aquatic environments formed by the accumulation in time and space of plant tissues under conditions of excessive humidity low nutrient availability low ph and oxygen scarcity where organic matter undergoes slow humification processes the peatland ecosystems of the southern espinha o mountain range located in minas gerais state brazil were formed by the sui generis combination of environmental factors source of its great biodiversity endemic and peculiar for thousands of years these ecosystems have been developing preserving proxies for environmental reconstitution sequestering more and more carbon and increasing their capacity to store water sponge effect and regulate the

flow of water courses environmental reconstitution studies carried out in these ecosystems have evidenced several regional paleoclimatic changes in the last 35 thousand years the stock of sequestered carbon is 4 877 840 tons and 142 138 262 m³ of water are stored in 14 288 ha of these peatlands these ecosystems constitute the headwaters of rivers in the most important basins in eastern brazil the são francisco jequitinhonha and doce river basins and regulate their flow during the dry period of the year however peatlands located outside protected areas are threatened by anthropization the long term ecological research program peatlands of the southern espinha¹o mountain range ecosystem services and biodiversity peld turf fund cnpq and fapemig started in 2021 intensified the characterization and monitoring of the biodiversity and ecosystem services of these peatlands the results of two decades of research revealed the importance of these ecosystems for biodiversity for the global carbon cycle for regional water resources and for paleoenvironmental reconstitution it was also evident that the rapid degradation of these ecosystems caused mainly by anthropization can irreversibly compromise in the medium term their ecosystem services biodiversity and paleoenvironmental reconstitution studies thus it is urgent to empower local and regional communities about the importance of peatland ecosystems both for the environment for the socio economy and for the quality of life of their populations as well as for the planet

in this volume nicholas r jones analyzes white appropriations of black african voices in spanish theater from the 1500s through the 1700s when the performance of africanized castilian commonly referred to as *habla de negros* black speech was in vogue focusing on spanish golden age theater and performative poetry from authors such as calderón de la barca lope de rueda and rodrigo de reinosa jones makes a strong case for revising the belief long held by literary critics and linguists that white appropriations and representations of *habla de negros* language are racist buffoonery or stereotype instead jones shows black characters who laugh sing and shout ultimately combating the violent desire of white supremacy by placing early modern iberia in

conversation with discourses on african diaspora studies jones showcases how black africans and their descendants who built communities in early modern spain were rendered legible in performative literary texts accessibly written and theoretically sophisticated jones s groundbreaking study elucidates the ways that habla de negros animated black africans agency empowered their resistance and highlighted their african cultural retentions this must read book on identity building performance and race will captivate audiences across disciplines

jack d forbes s monumental africans and native americans has become a canonical text in the study of relations between the two groups forbes explores key issues relating to the evolution of racial terminology and european colonialists perceptions of color analyzing the development of color classification systems and the specific evolution of key terms such as black mulatto and mestizo terms that no longer carry their original meanings forbes also presents strong evidence that native american and african contacts began in europe africa and the caribbean

a compelling and elegantly written history of the fight for the amazon basin and the work of a brilliant but overlooked brazilian intellectual times literary supplement uk the fortunes of the late nineteenth century s imperial powers depended on a single raw material rubber with only one source the amazon basin this scenario ignited a decades long conflict that found britain france belgium and the united states fighting with and against the new nations of peru bolivia and brazil for the forest s riches in the midst of this struggle the brazilian author and geographer euclides da cunha led a survey expedition to the farthest reaches of the river the scramble for the amazon tells the story of da cunha s terrifying journey the unfinished novel born from it and the global strife that formed the backdrop for both haunted by his broken marriage da cunha trekked through a beautiful region thrown into chaos by guerrilla warfare starving migrants and native slavery all the while he worked on his masterpiece a nationalist synthesis of geography philosophy biology

and journalism entitled *Lost Paradise* hoping to unveil the Amazon's explorers, spies, natives and brutal geopolitics. *Da Cunha* was killed by his wife's lover before he could complete his epic work. Once the biography of *Da Cunha*, a translation of his unfinished work and a chronicle of the social, political and environmental history of the Amazon, *The Scramble for the Amazon* is a work of thrilling intellectual ambition.

This is the most comprehensive and up-to-date book on the increasingly important and controversial subject of race relations in Brazil. North American scholars of race relations frequently turn to Brazil for comparisons since its history has many key similarities to that of the United States. Brazilians have commonly compared themselves with North Americans and have traditionally argued that race relations in Brazil are far more harmonious because the country encourages race mixture rather than formal or informal segregation. More recently, however, scholars have challenged this national myth, seeking to show that race relations are characterized by exclusion, not inclusion, and that fair-skinned Brazilians continue to be privileged and hold a disproportionate share of wealth and power. In this sociological and demographic study, Edward Telles seeks to understand the reality of race in Brazil and how well it squares with these traditional and revisionist views of race relations. He shows that both schools have it partly right: that there is far more miscegenation in Brazil than in the United States, but that exclusion remains a serious problem. He blends his demographic analysis with ethnographic fieldwork, history and political theory to try to understand the enigma of Brazilian race relations: how inclusiveness can coexist with exclusiveness. The book also seeks to understand some of the political pathologies of buying too readily into unexamined ideas about race relations. In the end, Telles contends the traditional myth that Brazil had harmonious race relations compared with the United States encouraged the government to do almost nothing to address its shortcomings.
