robert buswell a buddhist scholar who spent five years as a zen monk in korea draws on personal experience in this insightful account of day to day zen monastic practice in discussing the activities of the postulants the meditation monks the teachers and administrators and the support monks of the monastery of songgwang sa buswell reveals a religious tradition that differs radically from the stereotype prevalent in the west the author's treatment lucidly relates contemporary zen practice to the historical development of the tradition and to korean history more generally and his portrayal of the life of modern zen monks in korea provides an innovative and provocative look at zen from the inside

this book offers an accessible guide to the role that zen has played and alongside buddhism might play in both eastern and western attempts to alleviate mental suffering since its beginnings 2500 years ago the central belief of buddhism has been that what we perceive as reality is a mental representation a religious belief which has since been substantiated by the evidence of neuroscience the work and progress of clinical medicine psychiatry and psychology have attempted to alleviate the sufferings of life but the current approaches to mental health in psychiatry the neurosciences and cognitivism don't fully address the complexity and mutual inter relationship of the variety of factors involved in mental suffering and its non linear and chaotic aspects zen buddhism on the other hand encourages access to reality and so this book will explore scientifically the ways in which its guiding principles can be deployed to support and enhance

western clinical solutions to mental strife

artistic detachment in japan and the west takes up the notion of artistic detachment or psychic distance as an intercultural motif for east west comparative aesthetics the work begins with an overview of aesthetic theory in the west from the eighteenth century empiricists to contemporary aesthetics and concludes with a survey of various critiques of psychic distance throughout the author takes a highly innovative approach by juxtaposing western aesthetic theory against eastern primarily japanese aesthetic theory weaving between cultures and time periods the author focuses on a remarkably wide range of theories in the west the kantian notion of disinterested contemplation heidegger s gelassenheit semiotics and pragmatism in japan zeami s notion of riken no ken the kyoto school s interpretation of nothingness d t suzuki s analysis of the function of no mind and the writings of kuki shuzo on buddhist detachment portrait of the artist fiction by such writers as henry james james joyce mori ogai and natsume soseki demonstrates how the main theme of detachment is expressed in literary traditions the role of sympathy or pragmatism in relation to disinterest is examined suggesting conflicts within or challenges to the notion of detachment researchers and students in eastern and western areas of study including philosophers and religionists as well as literary and cultural critics will deem this work an invaluable contribution to cross cultural philosophy and literary studies

diana lobel takes readers on a journey across eastern and western philosophical and religious traditions to discover a beauty and purpose at the heart of reality that makes life worth living guided by the ideas of ancient thinkers and the insight of the philosophical historian pierre hadot the quest for god and the good treats philosophy not as an abstract theoretical discipline but as a living experience for centuries human beings have struggled to know why we are here whether a higher being or dimension exists and whether our existence is fundamentally good above all we want to know whether the search for god and the good will bring happiness following in the path of the ancient philosophers lobel directly connects conceptions of god or an absolute with notions of the good illuminating diverse classical texts and thinkers she explores the bible and the work of plato aristotle augustine maimonides al farabi and al ghazali she reads the tao te ching i ching bhagavad gita and upanishads as well as the texts of theravada mahayana and zen buddhism and traces the repercussions of these works in the modern thought of alfred north whitehead iris murdoch alasdair macintyre and charles taylor while each of these texts and thinkers sets forth a distinct and unique vision all maintain that human beings find fulfillment in their contact with beauty and purpose rather than arriving at one universal definition of god or the good lobel demonstrates the aesthetic value of multiple visions presented by many thinkers across cultures the quest for god and the good sets forth a path of investigation and discovery culminating in intellectual and spiritual communion

a critical history of the study of buddhism in the west incorporating insights of colonial and post colonial cultural studies social political and cultural conditions

that have shaped the course of buddhist studies are discussed

the kamakura period 1180 1333 is known as the era of japan s first warrior government as the essays in this book show however the period was notable for the coexistence of two centers of authority the bakufu military government at kamakura and the civilian court in kyoto with the newer warrior government gradually gaining ascendancy

the book is the volume of the history of religion in song liao jin and xixia dynasty among a series of books of deep into china histories the earliest known written records of the history of china date from as early as 1250 bc from the shang dynasty c 1600 1046 bc and the bamboo annals 296 bc describe a xia dynasty c 2070 1600 bc before the shang but no writing is known from the period the shang ruled in the yellow river valley which is commonly held to be the cradle of chinese civilization however neolithic civilizations originated at various cultural centers along both the yellow river and yangtze river these yellow river and yangtze civilizations arose millennia before the shang with thousands of years of continuous history china is one of the world s oldest civilizations and is regarded as one of the cradles of civilization the zhou dynasty 1046 256 bc supplanted the shang and introduced the concept of the mandate of heaven to justify their rule the central zhou government began to weaken due to external and internal pressures in the 8th century bc and the country eventually splintered into smaller states during the spring and autumn period these states became independent and warred with one another in the following warring states period much of traditional chinese culture literature and philosophy first developed during those troubled times in 221 bc qin shi huang conquered the various warring states and created for himself the title of huangdi or emperor of the qin marking the beginning of imperial china however the oppressive government fell soon after his death and was supplanted by the longer lived han dynasty 206 bc 220 ad successive dynasties developed bureaucratic systems that enabled the emperor to control vast territories directly in the 21 centuries from 206 bc until ad 1912 routine administrative tasks were handled by a special elite of scholar officials young men well versed in calligraphy history literature and philosophy were carefully selected through difficult government examinations china s last dynasty was the qing 1644 1912 which was replaced by the republic of china in 1912 and in the mainland by the people s republic of china in 1949 chinese history has alternated between periods of political unity and peace and periods of war and failed statehood the most recent being the chinese civil war 1927 1949 china was occasionally dominated by steppe peoples most of whom were eventually assimilated into the han chinese culture and

population between eras of multiple kingdoms and warlordism chinese dynasties have ruled parts or all of china in some eras control stretched as far as xinjiang and tibet as at present traditional culture and influences from other parts of asia and the western world carried by waves of immigration cultural assimilation expansion and foreign contact form the basis of the modern culture of china

while the philosophical discussion of zen spirituality reaches its limit poetry offers an effective expression of the sublime experiences from a poetic perspective enlightenment is understood as poetic leaps in the spiritual journey which brings people from the habitually or conventionally established world toward new horizons of consciousness this leap is a breakthrough in the overall consciousness rather than a progression in contemplative thought therefore it cannot be adequately described through abstract representation but poetry can metaphorically capture this leap and reveal both the spiritual meaning and the practical wisdom of enlightenment this book will take you on this fantastic journey of enlightenment

whilst happiness usually comes from how we think and feel about our life event based well being enlightenment is an internal experience not sourced from this process inner well being in this volume we look from a scientific point of view at the different approaches to enlightenment and the practices that trigger it this includes classical western approaches to contemplation and aesthetics eastern buddhist notions of satori modern predictors of self transcendent experiences assessments of current practitioners and their characteristics christian notions of mysticism hindu yoga practices the neuroscientific correlates of flourishing and the psychological stages in the journey to enlightenment we explore the evidence of these states traits and experiences the concepts underpinning them and the affect cognition and behaviour they transform

the problem of the will has long been viewed as central to heidegger s later thought focusing on this problem this book aims to clarify key issues from the philosopher s later period and demonstrates how his so called turn is not a simple turnaround from voluntarism to passivism

what could it mean to speak of philosophy as the education of grownups this book takes cavell s enigmatic phrase as a provocation to explore the themes of education that run throughout his work from his response to wittgenstein austin and ordinary language philosophy to his readings of thoreau and of the moral perfectionism he identifies with emerson to his discussions of literature and film hilary putnam has described cavell as not only one of the most creative thinkers

of today but as one of the few contemporary philosophers to explore philosophy as education cavell's sustained examination of the nature of philosophy cannot be separated from his preoccupation with what it is to teach and to learn this is the first book to address the importance of education in cavell's work and its essays are framed by two new pieces by cavell himself together these texts combine to show what it means to read cavell and simultaneously what it means to read philosophically in itself a part of our education as grownups

responding to plurality is a demanding task nonetheless it is one of the challenges that european countries are facing today over the past decades the social and religious make up of central europe has changed and this has led to resentment and fears of mass immigration social disintegration and the emergence of parallel societies however we also find empirical proof that prejudice is lowest where there is direct contact therefore there appears to be an increasing need for more dialogue in order to make the stranger less strange the unknown known the other no longer entirely other this is equally true in academic research there is a definite need yet research on questions of interreligious dialogue remains in its infancy throughout the various disciplines engaged in it the project religion and dialogue in modern societies redi that started at the academy of world religions at the hamburg university in 2011 seeks to contribute to remedying this deficit like the redi project this book looks at dialogue from different perspectives it includes both theoretical and empirical approaches as well as a variety of theological viewpoints on a theology of plurality and dialogue from the perspective of different religions

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
