the 20th century especially the latter decades was a time of explosive growth and importance in hymnody and yet published material about the hymnody of this period has been scattered and difficult to come by the present volume catalogues and categorizes the

available writings to guide students and scholars in their research furthermore this reference does not depend primarily on the view of the author compiler but guides users toward a broad spectrum of viewpoints about 20th century hymnody listing the principal writings on the repertory language practice and people of hymnody during the last century this annotated bibliography offers students and researchers alike a handy reference for a vast and varied field beginning with a unique introduction to and summary of hymnody in the 20th century music arranges the entries by topic dividing each chapter by helpful subject headings the repertory of the twentieth century and language issues are discussed practical elements of hymnody are covered while the final chapter lists writings about individual hymn writers and other influential persons in the field music provides a brief annotation for each entry and uses numerous cross references guiding the reader to relevant material in other sections of the book a comprehensive index concludes this essential reference

the seventh book of the stromateis is the culmination of clement of alexandria s ethic introduced as an apology of the piety of the perfect christian the gnostic it broaches such topics as divine pedagogy angelology superstition prayer assimilation to god martyrdom eschatology and the criteria of orthodoxy this volume contains sixteen studies dealing with all major themes of the seventh book and the method of their presentation it includes a clementine bibliography of the last fifteen years and two appendices concerned with clement s hymn to christ the saviour the publication may serve as a companion to the reader of stromateis vii and as a compendium of contemporary scholarship dealing with major aspects of clement s thought in general

this fully updated second edition is a selective annotated bibliography of all relevant published resources relating to church and worship music in the united states over the past decade there has been a growth of literature covering everything from traditional subject matter such as the organ works of j s bach to newer areas of inquiry including folk hymnology women and african american composers music as a spiritual healer to the music of mormon shaker moravian and other smaller sects with multiple indices this book will serve as an excellent tool for librarians researchers and scholars sorting through the massive amount of material in the field

to be valuable through specific episodes in presbyterian lutheran and reformed history hart presents a neglected form of protestantism confessionalism as an alternative to prevailing religious theory he explains that unlike evangelical and mainline protestants who emphasize faith's role in solving social and personal problems confessional protestants locate christianity's significance in the creeds ministry and rituals of the church although critics have accused confessionalism of encouraging social apathy hart deftly argues that this form of protestantism has much to contribute to current discussions on the role of religion in american public life since confessionalism refuses to confuse the well being of the nation with that of the church the history of confessional protestantism suggests that contrary to the legacy of revivalism faith may be most vital and influential when less directly relevant to everyday problems whether personal or social clear and engaging d g hart's groundbreaking study is essential reading for everyone exploring the intersection of religion and daily life

experts from the field of biblical studies shed light on the many ways in which the psalter psalms have been used through the ages the focus across the volume is on the role that these psalms play in scribal liturgical didactic iconographic and literary contexts the book is structured in four parts covering different styles uses of the psalms in part i song the focus is on psalms as songs and how their uses in different performative settings have generated new interpretations in part ii prayer the focus is on the liturgical uses of psalms not only how they can be used as prayers in various communities of faith but also on how they may not be used in part iii scripture interpretation the focus is on the reception of several individual psalms in jewish christian and muslim traditions finally in part iv scripture manuscripts the focus is on scribal activity transmission translation and illumination
