in the shadow of great powers is the second volume of christoph baumer s history of the caucasus it covers the period from the seljuk domination of the southern caucasus around 1050 ce to the present day after the kingdom of georgia s golden age of independent power and cultural blossoming in the 12th and early 13th centuries the caucasus was overrun by the mongols and soon disintegrated into innumerable smaller kingdoms principalities and khanates at the same time an armenian kingdom in exile maintained a precarious independence in cilicia today s southern turkey by applying a three way diplomatic policy balanced between the mongol il khanate the crusader states and to a lesser degree the mameluke empire then followed four centuries during which the highly fragmented polities of the north and south caucasus became political pawns of the regional great powers above all the ottomans iran and russia in the wake of world war i the south caucasus enjoyed a short lived independence whereas its northern neighbours were engulfed by the russian civil wars but by 1921 the soviet union had re established russian dominance over the whole region and from a western perspective the region disappeared behind the iron curtain nevertheless the caucasian nations kept their pronounced identities even under soviet rule giving rise at the dissolution of the soviet union to a number of internecine conflicts whereas the russian federation managed to maintain its supremacy over the north

caucasus albeit at the cost of bloody wars and insurrections armenia azerbaijan and georgia succeeded in more or less gaining control over their destiny of these three republics only azerbaijan secured a wide ranging independence thanks to its fossil fuel resources following russian interference georgia lost control over two of its provinces while armenia remains dependent on russian support in the face of its notoriously antagonistic relations with neighbouring azerbaijan and turkey over the unresolved issue of karabakh in the shadow of great powers includes some 200 full colour images and maps which further bring the turbulent history of this region to light

this book examines youth cultural responses to the political economic and socio cultural changes that affected britain in the aftermath of the second world war in particular it considers the extent to which elements of youth culture and popular music served to contest the notion of consensus that historians and social commentators have suggested served to frame british polity from the late 1940s into the 1970s the collection argues that aspects of youth culture appear to have revealed notable fault lines in and across british society and provided alternative perspectives and reactions to the presumptions of mainstream political and cultural opinion in the period this perhaps was most acute in the period leading up to and after the seemingly pivotal moment of margaret thatcher s election to prime minister in 1979 this book was originally published as a special issue of contemporary british history

legal and regulatory options and their underlying principles in the post 2008 legal regulatory architecture financial institution specific insolvency proceedings were further developed or implemented on both sides of the atlantic ten years after the most recent financial crisis there is sufficient empirical evidence to evaluate the outcomes of the bank bailouts in the us and the eu and to examine a number of cases under the eu s new bank resolution regime this book will be of interest of anyone in the field of finance banking central banking monetary policy and insolvency law

confederate artillery organizations an alphabetical listing of the officers and batteries of the confederacy 1861 1865 is a remarkable immensely useful and exceedingly rare book containing the names of the officers and every confederate artillery unit it is so rare that most scholars in the field don t even know of its existence it was originally published as simply confederate artillery organizations by the u s war department in 1898 one of marcus j wright s compilation aids to help assemble and organize the massive publication that would appear as the 128 volume the war of the rebellion a compilation of the official records of the union and confederate armies 1880 1901 known to researchers and students alike as simply official records editor ray sibley spent more than a decade researching the thousands of entries correcting mistakes and adding many artillery units and additional officers unknown to the original compilers more than a century ago sibley utilized archival records manuscripts letters diaries and other sources to verify the original work correct mistakes and add further useful information in the form of hundreds of valuable footnotes this new updated and easy to use reference work sets forth the lineage of the confederate artillery it lists in alphabetical order individual batteries to artillery regiments the names and alternate names for the batteries and the names of the men who led them also included are the dates of acceptance into confederate service for each unit most companies have an annotation that includes an alternate name if there was one and the date if a unit disbanded or was merged into another organization the annotations for officers include date of appointment date of promotion to a higher grade if any

date of transfers if any date dropped from rolls if any and date relieved of command if any confederate artillery organizations also contains four rare and hard to find lists of confederate artillery officers memorandum of artillery officers c s a list of officers corps of artillery c s army on u s register of 1861 superintendents of armories and military store keeper of ordnance these lists illustrate the ranking of each officer in his respective grade the extensive bibliography prepared by mr sibley is an invaluable guide to civil war historiography scholars researchers and students of the civil war will be thankful ray sibley turned his considerable talents to this project his tireless efforts made sure this rare book got back into print including all digital formats and turned what was once a valuable rare work into a reference book that is now both widely available and absolutely indispensable

america s nineteenth century preachers and religious leaders moved public sentiment and shaped the nation s moral character equally influencing events were america s preachers and religious leaders who moved public sentiment and shaped the nation s moral character in that class of great religious figures is the episcopal preacher and bishop phillips brooks the boston brahmin and harvard university graduate rose to heights as an anti slavery clergyman and indefatigable pastor to congregations in philadelphia and boston yet his many achievements must be balanced against his youthful arrogance and his shrewdness this book examines the spiritual and moral character of phillips brooks 1835 1893 as evidenced through

his life and ministry the volume's eight essays recognize the most recent academic contribution by gillis j harp brahmin prophet phillips brooks and the path of liberal protestantism 2003 but move beyond it in several crucial ways this new work seeks to reevaluate brooks considering the early twenty first century social and racial conflicts and subsequent cultural soul searching the contributors portray brooks as a man filled at times with hubris classism and prejudices and at other times with creative passion and pastoral concern for all peoples while mortals sleep focuses less on the external influences upon brooks and more on his actions and works within his historical context the essays seek to show his legacy in a present day light illustrating brooks at his best and worst

this book is the scholarly fully annotated edition of the award winning the illustrated to think like god to think like god focuses on the emergence of philosophy as a speculative science tracing its origins to the greek colonies of southern italy from the late 6th century to mid 5th century b c special attention is paid to the sage pythagoras and his movement the poet xenophanes of colophon and the lawmaker parmenides of elea in their own ways each thinker held that true insight whether as wisdom or certainty belonged not to mortal human beings but to the gods the pythagoreans sought to approach this otherworldly knowledge by studying numerical relationships believing them to govern the universe and that those who know the number of a thing know its true nature yet their quest was a hopeless one bogged down by cultism numerology political conspiracies bloody uprisings and exile above all number did not turn out as the most reliable of mediums it was certainly not a key to the realm of the divine thus their contributions to philosophy's inception while much better publicized was not the most significant that particular role was reserved for an unusual challenge and the elaborate reaction it provoked

the philocalia of origen is a collection of texts excerpted from the third century church father origen's numerous works it was created sometime in the fourth century perhaps by basil of caesarea and gregory of nazianzus it is of special

interest to scholars of origen because it contains several excerpts from works that are no longer extant or from works that are no longer extant in the greek language in which he wrote them but only in latin translations done in the fourth century or later the philocalia should also be of interest to beginners in the study of origen because it consists of rather short excerpts from a wide range of his writings homilies commentaries a theological treatise apologetics which cover some of the most important subjects he discussed many of the annotations in the work have been made especially for those unacquainted with origen s writings this reader s edition based on the greek text of j a robinson is the first new english translation of the philocalia of origen in a century
