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using case studies drawn from latin america africa india and eastern europe this volume examines the role of courts as a channel for social transformation for excluded sectors of society in contemporary democracies with a focus on social rights litigation in post authoritarian regimes or in the context of fragile state control the authors assess the role of judicial processes in altering or perpetuating social and economic inequalities and power relations in society drawing on interdisciplinary expertise in the fields of law political theory and political science the chapters address theoretical debates and present empirical case studies to examine recent trends in social rights litigation

trust courts and social rights proposes an innovative legal framework for judicially enforcing social rights that is rooted in public trust in government or political trust interdisciplinary in nature the book draws on theoretical and empirical scholarship on the concept of trust across disciplines including philosophy sociology psychology and political theory it integrates that scholarship with the relevant public law literature on social rights fiduciary political theory and judicial review in doing so the book uses trust as an analytical lens for social rights law importing ideas from the scholarship on trust into the social rights literature and develops a normative argument that contributes to the controversial debate on how courts should enforce social rights also global in focus the book uses cases from courts in africa europe latin america and north america to illustrate how the trust based framework operates in practice

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the concept of juridification refers to a diverse set of processes involving shifts towards more detailed legal regulation regulations of new areas and conflicts and problems increasingly being framed in legal and rights oriented terms this timely

social work in juvenile and criminal justice systems sets the standard of care for mental health treatment and the delivery of social services to crime victims juvenile and adult offenders and their families the chapters all authored by experts in the field and all committed to the mission of social

justice are written with the clear understanding that we cannot study criminal justice in a vacuum therefore a major focus of the book is on the renewed growing sense of the profession's obligation to social justice each chapter interconnects with the various components of juvenile and criminal justice another prominent aspect of the book is that it is strength based it views those involved in the criminal and juvenile justice systems as individuals rather than inmates or criminals each with unique positive talents and abilities the book is divided into four sections the first section discusses forensic social work including crime and delinquency theories trends and ethical issues the second section prepares social workers for practice in correctional institutions and explores crisis intervention with victims of violence reentry of adult offenders in society and aging in prison the third section covers assessment and intervention in child sexual abuse mental health and substance abuse interpersonal violence and prevention child welfare and juvenile justice the final section presents an overview on social work in the twenty first century which includes restorative justice and the justice system new ways of delivering justice domestic violence neighborhood revitalization race and ethnicity and social work practice with lgbtq offenders this book will be the best single source on social work in criminal justice settings and will prove to be an invaluable resource for the many professionals who have responsibility for formulating and carrying out the mandates of the criminal justice system

over the past few decades european countries have witnessed a proliferation of legal norms concerning marginalised individuals and minorities who increasingly invoke them in front of courts to assert their rights and claim protection the present volume explores the relationship between law rights and social mobilisation in europe it specifically enquires into the extent and ways in which legal processes and entitlements are mobilised by less privileged social actors to advance their rights claims and pursue social change most distinctly it explores such processes in the context of the multi level european system characterised by the existence of multiple legal and judicial arenas at the national subnational and supranational transnational level in such a complex system of law and governance in europe concepts

like legal opportunity structures as well as the factors shaping them need to be reconceptualised how does the multi level european context distinctly shape the nature and salience of rights as well as their mobilisation by individuals and minority actors

in order to make the criminal court system more effective there has been a growing trend to have courts participate in what is essentially a rehabilitation strategy such courts are often referred to as problem solving because they are working on root causes of criminal behavior as part of the dispensation of justice this major shift in the role of the courts means that the court works closely with prosecutors public defenders probation officers social workers and other justice system partners to develop a strategy that pressures offenders to complete a treatment program which will ultimately hopefully prevent recidivism research has shown that this kind of strategy has a two fold benefit it has been successful in helping offenders turn their lives around which leads to improved public safety and

the ultimate saving of public funds this book is the first to focus exclusively on problem solving courts and as such it presents an overview of the rationale and scientific evidence for such courts as well as individual sections on the key areas in which these courts are active thus there is specific attention paid to domestic violence juvenile criminality mental health and more throughout research findings are incorporated into general discussions of these courts operate and ideally what they are trying to accomplish there is also discussion of how such courts should evolve in the future and the directions that further research should take

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
