

The Epic Of Gilgamesh Penguin Classics

reflections on a lost poem and its rediscovery by contemporary poets gilgamesh is the most ancient long poem known to exist it is also the newest classic in the canon of world literature lost for centuries to the sands of the middle east but found again in the 1850s it tells the story of a great king his heroism and his eventual defeat it is a story of monsters gods and cataclysms and of intimate friendship and love acclaimed literary historian michael schmidt provides a unique meditation on the rediscovery of gilgamesh and its profound influence on poets today schmidt describes how the poem is a work in progress even now an undertaking that has drawn on the talents and obsessions of an unlikely cast of characters from archaeologists and museum curators to tomb raiders and jihadis fragments of the poem incised on clay tablets were scattered across a huge expanse of desert when it was recovered in the nineteenth century the poem had to be reassembled its languages deciphered the discovery of a pre noah flood story was front page news on both sides of the atlantic and the poem s allure only continues to grow as additional cuneiform tablets come to light its translation interpretation and integration are ongoing in this illuminating book schmidt discusses the special fascination gilgamesh holds for contemporary poets arguing that part of its appeal is its captivating otherness he reflects on the work of leading poets such as charles olson louis zukofsky and yusef komunyakaa whose own encounters with the poem are revelatory and he reads its many translations and editions to bring it vividly to life for readers

the relationship of myth to literature has largely been overshadowed in contemporary theory by perspectives of a linguistic or sociological orientation and by relativist sometimes negatory stances on all searches for meaning this book attempts to show that myth criticism and critical theories of more recent provenance are not irreconcilable while taking into consideration some of the more influential tenets of structuralist post structuralist marxist and feminist theory it applies a post jungian archetypal approach to illustrating the perennial nature of a particular myth the fall of man in two main traditions mesopotamian and christian and in the contemporary novel in english the discussions of five major novels by william golding patrick white martin amis salman rushdie and wilson harris not only serve to expand the mythological insights achieved in the first part of the book they also suggest the incommensurability of imaginal novelistic life with mythology s age old intuitions about the human condition myth criticism emerges from this book as an irreplaceable vantage point from which man s lapsarian predicament can be scrutinized synchronically as archaic wisdom contemporary anxiety and post colonial commitment to the building of a new human city

this is the first complete book about the babylonian kabbalah which many people are talking about on the internet assyria in northern iraq is the home of palace art from the courts of the assyrian empire where the tree of life was routinely shown on walls tended by winged genies it represented the king and the land it is also arguably a spiritual map and the basis of the jewish kabbalah which was developed later many authors have asserted that the kabbalah came from egypt but this book shows that its early roots lie in assyrian court art there are also fascinating parallels to asiatic shamanism all points to asia not africa as the home of the archetypal sacred tree image

this study traces the long evolution of the male military heroic tradition of the west and its reinvigoration by christian theology and ecclesiology it concludes with an analysis of the working out of this culture in debates about war crimes masculine concepts of duty and a war the gulf war on eurochristianity s frontier with islam

a mysterious group of people came to settle in southern mesopotamia sometime around 5400bc what is now the modern state of iraq the first city of mesopotamia was founded named eridu although historians have generally regarded this as the world s first city we have seen this challenged on numerous occasions by recent discoveries too numerous to mention here eridu had all the things we ordinarily associate with an ancient city temples administrative buildings housing agriculture markets art and of

course walls to keep out unsavoury characters the elusive aspect is we have absolutely no idea where they acquired their language and bizarre language it is we have no idea what they originally looked like their language which we call sumerian and the subsequent akkadian derivative were linguistic isolates sumerian is the oldest known written language on earth and any languages it might have derived from or developed alongside have been lost to time figuring out what their baffling ethnic identity based on their art is a doomed effort because their art was so stylized that a good case could be made that it portrays people of any ethnicity or the people they encountered the sumerian language was not semitic and the akkadian conquests of 2334 bce disrupted the ethnic and cultural isolation of the sumerian people by about 2000 bce the sumerians were speaking akkadian and the sumerian and akkadian civilizations were regarded as a single enterprise does this mean that we ll never know how the sumerian language developed or where the sumerians originally came from well if any reasonably well preserved sumerian bones can be found dna testing could tell us their ethnic origin although this all sounds murky we have literature left in the form of cuneiform writing that speaks volumes on their day to day life and their highly unusual gods the sumerian pantheon reads like wild science fiction at times and although they often speak of their own origins in terms of their gods and family ties many have chosen to label this as mythology ignore it or merely treat it in a literature aspect

from ancient times to the present day the world in books offers a wide ranging historical education through pleasure reading and a fantastic introduction to some of the most thought provoking profound and interesting nonfiction works of all time from sun tzu s the art of war to bell hooks s all about love as well as such recent classics as barbara ehrenreich s nickel and dimed and chimamanda ngozi adichie s we should all be feminists davis s guide suggests a world of nonfiction books and explains just why they re so historically meaningful and culturally relevant today

the author of bloodline of the gods explores the theory that ancient aliens shared the

secrets of immortality with old testament figures while scientists debate the theoretical possibility of immortality it may have already been achieved in the distant past history is filled with accounts of fantastic beings powerful gods and half human half alien entities that had extraordinarily long lifespans today these stories are dismissed as mere folklore and mythology but what if the accounts are all too real in immortality of the gods nick redfern considers the possibility that ancient aliens uncovered the secret to stopping the aging process examining the legends of the anunnaki redfern investigates how these ancient deities may have achieved everlasting life and why they might have shared their secrets with noah methuselah and other biblical figures redfern goes on to explore the saga of gilgamesh a long lived part human part extraterrestrial sumerian ruler obsessed with immortality also in this volume redfern studies the claim that an undisclosed motivation for the 2003 invasion of iraq was to uncover the millennia old secrets of white powder gold a manna like substance that supposedly rejuvenates cells and tissue
