this paper reports the results of remapping the mountain grove pluton situated in the sharbot lake domain in the central part of the central metasedimentary belt grenville province ontario the pluton previously mapped as a single body of gabbroic rock is now described as comprising two distinct intrusions the paper begins with an overview of its

geologic setting then describes the lithology of the two intrusion units associated dykes and neighbouring intrusions plutons the geochronology of the pluton and its mineral deposits are also briefly noted
