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whether you re meeting them for the first time or returning with questions this is the indispensable guide to the lives and works of the puritans if your impression of the puritans comes from grim portraits high collars and joyless sermons meet the puritans will surprise you in the best way behind those caricatures lies a warm christ centered spiritual tradition shaped by people who loved scripture treasured grace and sought to glorify god in every part of life the puritans took life seriously because they took god seriously grace and guilt love and sacrifice heaven and hell weren t abstractions to them they were urgent realities today when conviction of sin is dismissed as gloom when earnest faith is pitied and when diligent obedience is labeled as legalism we desperately need their witness if you hunger for depth for holiness for real communion with god open these pages let these lives challenge you and these writings nourish you take the time to meet the puritans you ll find in them deep truths godly examples and an exalted christ this new edition includes 45 new biographies for a total of 190 english and american puritans seventeenth century scottish presbyterians and dutch further reformation divines 278 new summaries of puritan works with annotated bibliographies of modern reprints comprehensive revision of the entire previous edition 200 new titles added to the select bibliography of secondary sources new expanded glossary plus an updated expanded list of puritan publishers the definitive reference for engaging the puritan tradition praised by pastors scholars and serious readers alike substantial enough for study accessible enough for devotional use meet the puritans is that rare kind of reference book that invites you to actually read it if you re serious about reading the puritans or simply looking for a clear starting point this is the place to begin

from witch trials to pickaxe murderers from brothels to convents and from slavery to toni morrison s paradise these essays provide fascinating and provocative insights into our sexual and religious conventions and beliefs

originally published in 1967 this book is a history of church puritanism as a movement and as a political and ecclesiastical organism of its membership structure and internal contradictions of the quest for a further reformation it tells the fascinating story of the rise of a revolutionary

moment and its ultimate destruction

members of the church of england until the mid 16th century the puritans thought the church had become too political and needed to be purified while many puritans believed the church was capable of reform a large number decided that separating from the church was their only remaining course of action thus the mass migration of puritans known as pilgrims to america took place although puritanism died in england around 1689 and in america in 1758 puritan beliefs such as self reliance frugality industry and energy remain standards of the american ideal the a to z of puritans tells the story of puritanism from its origins until its eventual demise this is done through a chronology an introduction a bibliography and several hundred cross referenced dictionary entries on important people places and events

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in the year 2000 two young editors nicholas blincoe and matt thorne published all hail the new puritans an anthology of short stories which created an impact in the somewhat faded literary scene of britain at the turn of the millennium the stories themselves written by 15 young english writers scarlett thomas alex garland ben richards nicholas blincoe candida clark daren king geoff dyer matt thorne anna davis bo fowler matthew branton simon lewis tony white toby litt and rebecca ray together with the editors manifesto offered a new and stimulating approach to

fiction although the whole project had an outrageous reception by the literary establishment for the first time a collection of essays addresses the importance of the new puritan movement and provides guidelines to understand this generation of writers

this collection of essays by leading scholars in the field reveals the major contribution of puritan women to the intellectual culture of the early modern period it demonstrates that women's roles within puritan and broader communities encompassed translating and disseminating key texts producing an impressive body of original writing

thomas middleton 1580 1627 our other shakespeare is the only other renaissance playwright who created lasting masterpieces of both comedy and tragedy he also wrote the greatest box office hit of early modern london the unique history play a game at chess his range extends beyond these traditional genres to tragicomedies masques pageants pamphlets epigrams and biblical and political commentaries written alone or in collaboration with shakespeare webster dekker ford heywood rowley and others compared by critics to aristophanes and ibsen racine and joe orton he has influenced writers as diverse as aphra behn and t s eliot though repeatedly censored in his own time he has since come to be particularly admired for his representations of the intertwined pursuits of sex money power and god the oxford middleton prepared by more than sixty scholars from a dozen countries follows the precedent of the oxford shakespeare in being published in two volumes an innovative but accessible collected works and a comprehensive scholarly companion though closely connected each volume can be used independently of the other the collected works brings together for the first time in a single volume all the works currently attributed to middleton it is the first edition of middleton's works since 1886 the texts are printed in modern spelling and punctuation with critical introductions and foot of the page commentaries they are arranged in chronological order with a special section of juvenilia the volume is introduced by essays on middleton's life and reputation on early modern london and on the varied theatres of the english renaissance extensively illustrated it incorporates much new information on middleton's life canon texts and contexts a self consciously federal edition the collected works applies

contemporary theories about the nature of literature and the history of the book to editorial practice

a classic documentary collection on new england s puritan roots is once again available with new material

this book reconsiders the role of seventeenth century puritanism in the creation of the united states and its consequent cultural and literary histories

charles haddon spurgeon 1834 1892 was the most famous baptist minister of his generation for such a significant figure he has received surprisingly little scholarly coverage this present work seeks to make a contribution to spurgeon studies by examining him through the lens of his spirituality a wealth of primary material much of it previously untapped is used to build up a picture of his spiritual life whereas older and more recent interpretations of spurgeon have a tendency to be one dimensional examination of his spirituality reveals him to be a complex figure one who was molded by a diverse range of factors despite this complexity a unifying theme for spurgeon s spirituality is traced and fresh light is shed on the foremost popular preacher of the victorian age

contributes to an understanding of the internal political and religious structure of the city of london during the period of the english revolution this monograph reconstructs the social structure and composition of each of the city parishes surveys the successes and failures of presbyterianism among the parishes explores the new relationship between the puritan ministers and the parishes as well as discusses the independents and the anglicans in this time and setting

congregationalists the oldest group of american protestants are the heirs of new england s first founders while they were key characters in the story of early american history from plymouth rock and the founding of harvard and yale to the revolutionary war their luster and numbers have faded but margaret bendroth s critical history of congregationalism over the past two centuries reveals how the denomination is essential for understanding mainline protestantism in the making bendroth chronicles how the new england puritans known for their moral and doctrinal rigor came to be the antecedents of the united church of christ one of the most liberal of all protestant denominations today the demands of competition in the american religious marketplace spurred congregationalists bendroth argues to face their distinctive history by engaging deeply with their denomination s storied past they recast their modern identity the soul searching took diverse forms from letter writing and eloquent sermonizing to pilgrim celebrating thanksgiving pageants as congregationalists renegotiated old obligations to their seventeenth century spiritual ancestors the result was a modern piety that stood a respectful but ironic distance from the past and made a crucial contribution to the american ethos of religious tolerance

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
