literature the story is told with such marked faithfulness such honesty of expression such vividness of portrayal that those who lived in and passed through those scenes or similar ones will at once recognize the situations and surroundings as natural and real while perusing its pages the veteran will again live in the days gone by when he tramped the dusty march joined in the terrible charge or suffered in the army hospital the heroine of this book performed her part well but it is doubtful whether at the time she fully realized the heart felt thanks and noble thoughts that sprang from the boys in blue in response to her heroism and kindness how vividly is presented the weary march to the field of conflict our eagerness to quaff the sparkling water as she handed it to us fresh from the cooling spring we thanked her but she did not hear the full gratitude that was in our hearts

preface

provides background on the bloodiest battle in the civil war a day by day account of the fighting and a discussion of the battle s aftermath

a string of confederate victories at second manassas fredericksburg and chancellorsville led to the june 1863 invasion of pennsylvania by general robert e lee s army of northern virginia as lee was aiming toward harrisburg the state capital general george g meade s army of the potomac drove hard to catch up with him although neither general had planned to fight at the small crossroads town of gettysburg a skirmish broke out on july 1 when advance elements of the confederate army collided with pickets from a yankee cavalry brigade three days of bitter fighting ensued when the vicious encounter was over having been fought at places like the railroad cut devil s den the wheatfield little round top and culp s hill and culminating in pickett s desperate charge on july 3 lee s army was in retreat and meade had scored a major victory for the north based on deep knowledge of the battle and battlefield and driven by masterful excitingly paced storytelling they met at gettysburg is the classic narrative of the greatest battle ever fought on american soil

it s july 1863 the civil war is at a turning point the confederacy has won some important battles despite having fewer soldiers and resources than the union does the two great armies are marching to the same rural fields near the small town of gettysburg pennsylvania what will happen there could change the course of the war and the future of the united states experience the battle as seen from both sides

the events surrounding the battle of gettysburg did not look the same to everyone involved understanding depends on perspective in the viewpoints and perspectives series more advanced readers will come to understand different viewpoints by learning the context significance and details of the civil war battle through the eyes of three different people while engaging with text through questions sparking critical thinking books include timeline glossary and index

includes 30 maps and plans to illustrate the bloody engagement at gettysburg originally published as a 72 page pamphlet for private circulation only and then first published in full print in 1908 this story of the battle of gettysburg was written by lieutenant haskell to his brother h m haskell of portage not long after the contest although not originally intended for publication its great merit was at once recognized and the account was widely read by military experts and received much praise for both its literary and its professional merit

writing of gettysburg which is herein so graphically depicted by haskell general francis a walker in his history of the second army corps refers to our author as one who was bravest of the brave riding mounted through an interval between the union battalions and calling upon the troops to go forward he further says colonel frank a haskell of wisconsin had been known for his intelligence and courage for his generosity of character and his exquisite culture long before the third day of gettysburg when acting as aide to general gibbon he rode mounted between the two lines then swaying backward and forward under each other s fire calling upon the men of the second division to follow him and setting an example of valor and self devotion never forgotten by any man of the thousands who witnessed it

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
